
And Then Shall The End Come



From The Sermons Of William Marrion Branham

Matthew 24:14

And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Listen what the Prophet of God said about it:

29 So, you see, where the Christianity in its theology, how weak it is. God never invented that in the first place. Jesus never did say, "Build churches, seminaries." He said, "Preach the Gospel into all the world," then He'd would return. See? But we've done everything else but do what He told us to do. He can't return till the Gospel's been preached. He said, "You'll hear of signs and wars and rumors of wars, (Not yet) parents against children, children..." (That's not yet.) But said "When this Gospel has been preached to all of the world, then the end will be." He would return.

There is the mission of the Church, is to preach the Gospel, demonstrate the power. Oh, we've passed tracts everywhere. But that ain't what it takes. It takes the power and demonstration of the Holy Spirit, truly. Now, watch.

54 Now, God in the...After the antediluvian destruction, when He saved the household of Noah, Noah and his sons and their wives. Noah had three sons: Ham, Japheth, and—and Shem, and out of those sprung the generations of peoples that we have today.

55 We're taught in another phase that the three wise men that came to worship Jesus, consulting one another, found out one was

from the—the lineage of Ham, one from Shem, and Japheth, those three.

Gospel's been preached to Ham, Shem, and Japheth's people, then the end shall come. The three ancient fathers coming to pay tribute as they followed the morning star to Christ.

54-0306 — The Unconditional Covenant That God Made With His People 4 After all...We know that we like to see everybody well. We like to see people that's hungry be fed. But you know, the soul is the most important thing of anything in the mortal. 'Cause that's the thing that lasts forever. And I...

And you know, when...I believe that every Christian is obligated to be a missionary. I believe every Christian is obligated. Now, not so much as you have to go over in the old countries and preach or

something. But if you can't go, you can help send somebody else. You see? See? What you do to send somebody else...

And did you ever think what Jesus said about when the disciples asked Him when He would return again? Why, He said...Show us the sign that when He would return; He said, "You'll hear of wars and rumors of wars." (That'll be all right.) "You'll hear of fathers against mothers, and mothers, and

parents against children, and so forth." But that's not yet. He said, "There'll be time when they'd be all different, and it... The morals... They'd marry and given in marriage and so forth." It's not yet. But He said, "When this Gospel is preached to all the world, then He'd return." And where have we done, Christian friends? We've failed miserably. Is that right? I am...

67 Now, Jesus never did tell us to go build churches, although that's good, Jesus never did tell us to have an organization, though that's good, He never did tell us to build hospitals, though that's good, He never did tell us to have seminaries, though that's good, but the thing that He told us to do, we have substituted these things that I've just spoken, in place of what He told us to do: "Go ye into all the world and preach the

Gospel." Not build churches, not organize people, not educate them, but preach the Gospel.

68 Jesus said there would be signs be happening, but here is the—the great sign: that He promised to return. He said, "When this Gospel has been preached to all the world for a witness," then He would return; and He won't return and He can't return until that has been done. Jesus is depending on the Church to carry out His orders. And we

substituted teachings of theology, and so forth, and left off the real, main commission that He told us to do: Preach the Gospel.

69 Well, then some of you would say, "Well, Brother Branham, haven't we preached the Gospel all these years?"

70 With reverence I say, "No." See?

71 Did you know that two-third of the world has never even heard one word about Jesus Christ? Two-

thirds of the population of this world has never heard of the Lord Jesus Christ; one-third. And Christianity is about three or four place behind, first the Mohammedan, Buddha, and so forth, then Christianity, that's including all Protestant and Catholic put together. See how far we are behind?

13 Jesus said, "Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature." And when this is done, then the end time shall be. When the Gospel has reached the world, our blessed Saviour said, "Then the end shall be."

Now, He never said when you've passed tracts over the world, or when you sent Bibles over the world, or when you have sent missionaries over the world,

but when this Gospel has been preached. What is the Gospel then? Paul said, "The Gospel came to us not in Word only, but through the power and the demonstrations of the Holy Spirit," the Holy Spirit making the Word manifest. For if you follow the very next verse, when He said, "Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature," He said, "These signs shall follow them that believe. Lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the world," to

manifest Himself the same yesterday, today, and forever.

58-0109 - The Called-Out

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42 Brotherly love. It was a great age of missionaries and missions. The world has never seen the time, it even goes over into our time now, that, when the world ever seen such a time of missionaries everywhere. In the last...Oh, I'd say

the last hundred and fifty years, it's been one of the most outstanding times of world history for missionaries getting into all parts of the world with the Gospel. It has been...

43 As far as literally—as literally, just going, sending the message of the Gospel on paper and tracts and books and so forth, the Gospel has long ago went to every nation under the heavens, long ago. So, you see, that goes to prove that that wasn't what Jesus was talking

about. He never said, "Go into all the world and make Bible schools." Neither did He say, "Go into all the world and pass out literature."

44 Those things are fine, but His commission to the Church was, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel." And the Gospel is not altogether the Word, but It's making the Word come to Life. Because Jesus said, See? immediately, "These signs shall follow them that believe." You know, Mark 16, His last—His last

mission to the Church was, "These signs shall follow them that believe." His first commission to the Church, in Matthew the 10th chapter, was, "Heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out devils; as freely as you have received, freely give." And His last Message to the Church was, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved, he that believeth not shall be damned, and

these signs shall follow them that believe."

45 Isn't it strange that many cut off that part there? "And" is a conjunction that ties your sentence together, see. Now, He said, (Many of ministers will say, "Go preach the Gospel.") "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved, and he that believeth not shall be damned, and these signs shall follow them. Shall follow them; them that believe. In My Name they shall cast out devils;

they shall speak with new tongues. If they take up serpents, or drink a deadly thing, it'll not harm them; if they lay their hands on the sick, they shall recover." Signs of the living God moving among the people. Oh! How far now? To all the world. You get it? All the world.

46 So therefore when I say that the pentecostal Message...(Not the Pentecostal organization now.) The pentecostal Message is the only true Message from God. Now look, Mark 16, if you're reading it

there. All right, right here Jesus commissioned His Church, "Go into all the world; preach the Gospel; these signs: speaking in tongues, healing the sick, performing miracles..." Will last till how far? "All the world." Howhow many? "To every creature." That's all the way down to the end here, "To the consummation." All right. These signs shall follow just this church? "Them that believe, in all the world. All the world, to every creature, these signs shall

follow them." Not *this*, "them" that believe. So it's a pentecostal Church. See?

47 Now, we have took in this age, right here where we're at tonight on the Philadelphian, *P-h-i-/*, the Philadelphian Church Age. In that age there, evangelize and has missionaried, all the complete world with literature.

48 Jesus said, "When this Gospel is preached—this Gospel is preached to all the world for a

witness unto Me, then the end shall be." Well, then, if that was what He was talking about, spreading out literature, sending out missionaries with reading, writing, arithmetic, and passing out tracts and making people shake hands and believe that there is a God, if that's all it was, then He's far past His coming. Uh-huh. So it shows that the Gospel...Paul said, "The Gospel didn't come in word only, but through power and manifestations of the Holy Ghost."

49 Then when Jesus said, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel," He said, "Go into all the world and demonstrate!" Oh, I like that. "Demonstrate the power of the Gospel." Taking the Word, that what It says, and show the people what It says and then make It manifest to them. Oh, that's the way. That proves It.

60-1210 – The Philadelphian Church Age 200 Now, Jesus was asked, "When shall the time come when there won't be one stone left upon another? And what is the sign of the coming of the end of the world? When is it going to be?"

201 And He begin to tell them, "This Gospel will be preached to every nation, kingdom, for a witness unto Me." You know what? Now, He never said...He said, "This Gospel," now, He didn't say, "Go teach the Word," but, "Preach the Gospel," there's a lot difference, certainly. The Gospel is the power and demonstration of

the Word, see, the power and demonstrations of the Word.

202 You remember when that Angel come down on the river, which you have the picture of it, and you know about, when It said here about, in 1933, when I was baptizing my first group, that the Message would sweep the world? And every nation, they've got a revival going, they've had it everywhere. See? Sure. Pulling the Elected out. That's right. "This Gospel shall be preached."
