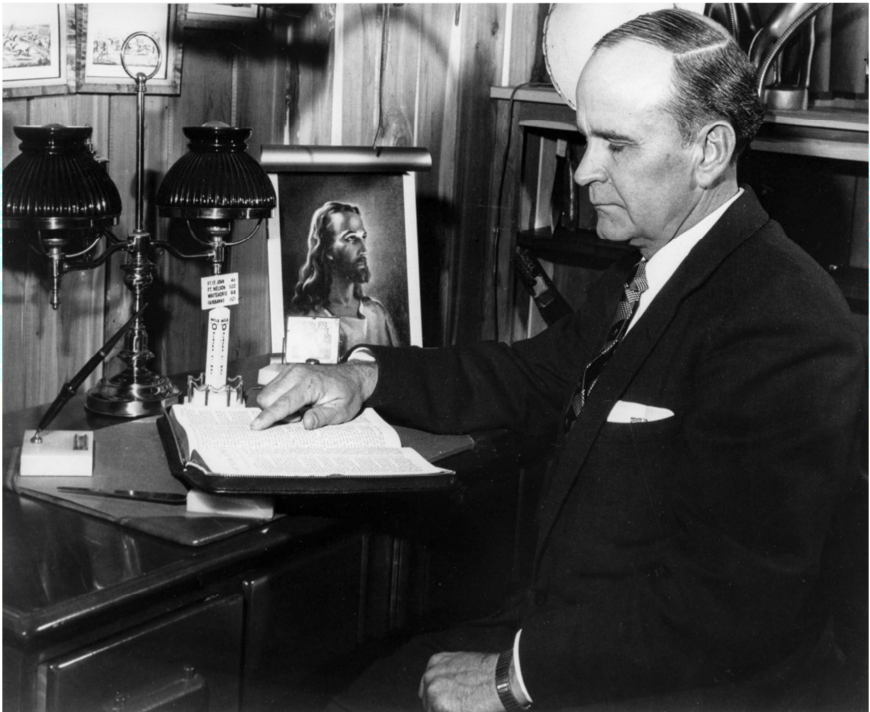

Psalms 9:9

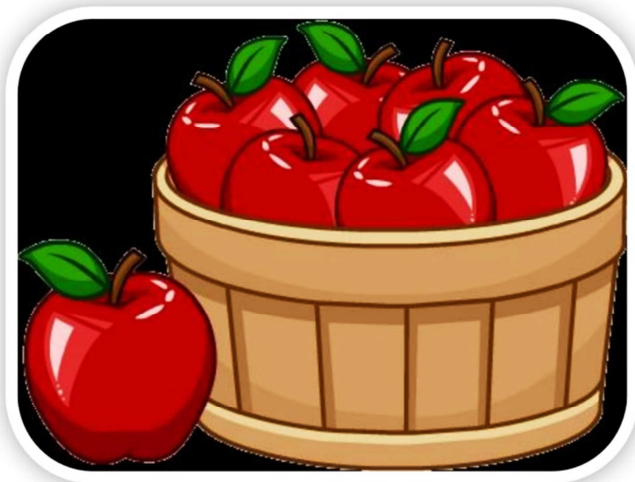
9. The LORD also will be a
