42 India, they're trying to become...to make interrupt the human part of man, and make them become sterile, that children cannot be born, because they're—they are in on the increase so. Four hundred and seventy million, at this time, in India.

43 How about China, where the increase is greater, Russia and the many countries of the world? "When man begin to multiply upon the face of the earth." See? Now we're taking back to the antediluvian time.

...and daughters were born unto them,

And the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took unto them wives...all which they chose.

And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be a a hundred and twenty years.

And there were giants in the land in those days; and also after them...the sons of God came...to the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, and the same became mighty men which were of old,...renown.

38 How much more is it, then, when we see a flashing signal that He's in the blocks! The old Gospel train is passing by, pretty soon. And as we study tonight on this great text, flashing signal, as our Lord set upon the mountain and told them these things would take place, "As it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be in the coming of the Son of man." 39 Now we want to go back, for a little piece, and find out if we can find anything in this day that resembles the days of Noah. And then we can tell then where we are in that day that our Lord spoke of, see if we can find just any resemblance of the days of Noah. In order to do this, I think we ought to go back to the Book of Genesis, to the days of Noah. And if you will turn with me, if you will, in the Scripture, back to Genesis the 6th chapter, and that's the days of the flood, and the morals and the conditions of that day, Genesis the 6th chapter. Now, we want to read, see and compare that day with this day. Notice.

And it came to pass, when men begin to multiply upon the face of the earth,...

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Let's start at the change of the dispensations again, from the Adam, Adamic dispensation unto the Noahic dispensation. Now—now just before that time come, let's just look at—at what's taken place. Let's start, start with the 6th chapter of Genesis, and just read a few verses.

And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and the daughters were born unto them,

And the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

9 I was reading that some time ago and was commenting on it, preaching on it. And then I caught, Jesus read the same Genesis that I read and you read. So I went back in Genesis 6, to find out what they did in that day, and we find out that "the sons of God taken unto them daughters of men." I looked at their translation on there, said, "taken unto them women," not daughters. That was just like a Reno, Nevada; just marriage, divorce, like Hollywood, and so forth. And then said, "these were men renown, of old."

10 Then you seen the *Life* magazine, where this great scandal come up in England, of those renown men, and those prostitutes and things, and how that our governors. And, oh, my, what a conglomeration we're in, just exactly the picture Jesus said would take place, see. "Eating, drinking, marrying, given in marriage, and knew it not until the day that Noah entered into the ark." 11 And then the door was closed. There was no more chance. That was his last sermon. The last sermon that's been preached in any great ministry has been to the impossible to be saved. Noah, his last message was to the impossible to be saved. See, he went in and the door closed behind him, and he was in there seven days before it started raining. See, his message first was preaching, building the ark, and then closed up seven days.

12 The people said, "That old fanatic. See, he's just in there, he closed the door himself." But God closed it. Same thing was in Sodom.

126 We see the signs of the Lord Jesus healing the sick, raising the dead, casting out evil spirits. We see the—the people made saintly and holy, by the Holy Spirit. We see lives changed. We see great signs. We see mystic signs in the skies, like flying saucers. The Pentagon, many of the people putting it on television, writing it up. They don't know what to think about it. All kinds of mysterious signs! The Lord Jesus coming down in a form of a Pillar of Fire, have His picture taken, living among us, proving that He's the same yester-...

127 We see all these things happening. We see the coldness of the church. We see the denomination growing. "When you see the fig tree, and all the other trees putting forth their buds," Jews returning. "The fig tree," Jews returning to their nation, their own country. We see the Presbyterians, the Methodists, the Baptists, the the Pentecostals. all Lutheran. the churches, "putting forth their leaves," revival. He said, "Get ready! That's the time." When we see that coming to pass, that's when God is fixing to call His Elect. Then when you...

Another sign. Said, "When you see the women becoming extremely pretty, when you see the sons of God taken them with wives, and taken unto them wives, and doing *this, that,* or the *other,*" said, "know that that's the sign." Here we are.

If that ain't a picture of the modern day believer today, he's considered totally insane. He's emotional. He's crazy. I thank the brother at the end here for his compliment, "I was just foolish enough to believe the Word." That's all right. I—I want to stay foolish.

I seen a little sign one time. I'm told about a man out in California, had a big plate on the front of him here. It said, "I'm a fool for Christ." And on his back with a question mark, said, "Whose fool are you?" So...

25 Noah, as we talked on him last night, or about him, when he heard the voice of God speak to him and told him of the oncoming judgment... 47 Then we find, in the days of Noah, those who believed his message and come in, was saved, and those that rejected his message perished. He give them a sign of building an ark.

48 In the days of Moses, God's speaking through human lips could call flies, fleas, frogs, close the heavens, make it dark, by a prophet that was thoroughly a vindicated. Those who believed and come out of Egypt, across the dividing line of the Red Sea, was saved. Those who was on the other side, perished.

62 God told Noah to make that ark out of shittim wood, and that wood's lighter than

93 Why, I imagine, sometime the ark was standing on the end, and upside down, and

everything else. But Noah was safe. The pitch stood between him and the judgment.

94 And, today, the Blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, stands between us and all the Judgment. Amen. "Shall not be condemned, or come into Judgment, but passed from death unto Life." Amen. Why? Because he is in the ark. What a perfect picture!

Into the Greek, I find out that pitch meant one thing, meant, too, a substance. But, how they got pitch, they beat it out of another tree. It was like a resin, and they beat it out and boiled it, and then poured it on. And it become pitch.

80 What a beautiful thing, of the wood before it's cut down, a certain type of timber, being human. Christ, in His humility, being human. And the Church, His ark today, coming into His Church, which is no more than His Own spiritual Body here on earth. That, Christ was cut down, and life was beat out of Him, that it might be applied to the Church.
