32. And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

33. And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them,

34. Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon.

Luke 24:35

35. And they told what things were done in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking of bread.

13. And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs.

Listen what the Prophet of God said about it:

43 Here was many of the disciples, all disheartened, many things had come up in life, just like we get ourself, along this journey. They were on their road home, going over to Emmaus, Cleopas and his companion, walking along the road. And how little did they know, on this beautiful first Easter morning, that Jesus Christ was alive and among the people. They thought He was dead.

44 And as they did then, so is it now. Many people who really love Jesus fail to understand that He is right with us, living, resurrected, here among us. They teach it as a historical affair of something; and it is a history. The Bible is not only a history, but It's a prophet, also. He is not only dead, but He raised again. He died, truly, but He rose again from the dead.

44 When He went to Calvary, it held. When He went to death, it held. God proved that inoculation would keep you from sin. Not only that, but on Easter morning, blessed be the Name of the Lord, the inoculation held. After He was dead three days, and His body in a grave, the inoculation held. It rose from the grave on Easter morning by that inoculation.

All the people begin to look around, and say, "That inoculation looks good to me." The real believer.

44 We noticed the disciples, one time, after the...Well, it was the first Easter morning. What a morning! Jesus, up from the dead, walking among the flowers. And two friends, Cleopas and one of his friends, was on the road down to Emmaus. And they were walking along talking, grieved at their heart. And a Man stepped out of the bush, and walked with them the rest of the day, talking to them about Christ. And that evening, they asked Him. He act like He was going to pass them by, but they asked Him to come in. He did.

45 And, when He did, He did something there the way He done it before His crucifixion and His resurrection. Before He was crucified, they seen Him do it just like He did. They recognized it was Him, though been with Him all day long and never recognized Who He was.

66 Now, look. One more little thought. When Jesus was crucified and was buried, the disciples thought, "Well, that's it." See? "That's all we'll ever see of Him." I want you to watch just a few moments.

There was two of them, who was on the road to Emmaus, one morning, going over to Emmaus. Some of them went fishing. Oh, they were discouraged, going along talking along the road, saying, "Well, here we go back home again, and take up our old tasks going over to Emmaus," Cleopas and his friend, as they walked along the road. That's the same way Jesus does today. In my heart, on my mind, all day long, let me walk with the Lord in the light of His Word, with the heavenly Dove, let me have fellowship all day long.

28 On the road to Emmaus, on that first Easter morning when the whole world was in bloom with flowers, buds, the bees a humming, on that beautiful April morning, little did the disciples know that He was raised from the dead, and was among the resurrection. 43 It's when Cleopas and his friends from the—the first Easter, on the road down to Emmaus, while they were speaking and thinking about Him, that He stepped out of the bushes and begin to talk to him. It's when we're talking about Him, when we're thinking about Him.

We can't be out there running around, doing one thing and another. The church has got too many programs. We ought to get back to God, the old prayer meetings, and—and a real back Pentecost, back in the church. We got too much outside things to do, too many societies to take care of. We've got to come back. Yeah, entertainment... That's right.

The American people want to be entertained. They stay home on Wednesday night to see "Who Loves Sucy," ever what that program is. That shows what's in your heart. If you loved God, you'd be at church. You've got to get back to the church. Back to the Bible, back to Christ.

69 When this crowd leaves this fairgrounds tonight and starts back to their home... Lord, one day after You had been crucified and buried, they thought it was all over. You were dead and buried and that was all. There were two men Cleopas and his friend was on the road down to Emmaus.

Somebody walked with them all day long, speaking to them about the Word of God. They didn't recognize Who it was, but when You got them that night, You got them inside the building and closed the doors. He did something before them just like He did before He was crucified. Light-footed, lighthearted they run back to tell the rest of the disciples, "Indeed the Lord has risen."

62 Notice, as they went now, two of them, Cleopas and his friend was on their road to Emmaus. And it was Sunday morning. So they was on their road over there, talking. They was going along the road, real sad. My, they were really let down with something, looked like a veil.

124 He dressed like the rest the man. He wore His hair and His beard just like the rest of them did. He didn't...He wasn't any different. He didn't make any great different. His life proved what His credentials, what He was. And that's what God wants us to be; wants our life to be our credentials. That's right.

And we are not redeeming the time, but we're giving it to the things of the world instead of our time to the Lord Jesus. And the Bible said, that, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that proceedeth from the mouth of God." Christians live on the Word.

65 Look at—look at Cleo—Cleopas and them. They was walking along and saying, "Well, I guess it's all over. He's dead. We seen Him killed. We seen the spear go through His heart and died the day before yesterday. And well, we might as well go back home. That's all. Yeah, got a story down there that these women said they saw Him. But course, we heard the report. The Jews come and stole Him away, took Him out. I wonder what's happened."

A Stranger walked out and said, "Good morning, brethren."

"Good morning, sir."

Said, "What are you so sad about?"
Said, "Are you a stranger and don't know that Jesus of Nazareth, Who we expected to be the King of Israel, has dead. This is the third day and so forth and..."

"Why," He said, "Foolish of heart, slow to understand." Watch. The first thing He went was right straight to the Scripture. And that's where Jesus always hits us.
