126 In the days of Enoch, just before the flood, when Enoch looked out there and saw Noah building away on that ark. Enoch was a prophet. Enoch knew that he was a type. And he knew, that before the floods came, that he had to give an example, so afternoon it was one becoming to him to take a walk. It was becoming that he'd take this walk with God. And, somehow, that day he changed his path. Instead of going around the side of the hill, he took the King's Highway, and he just kept on walking. "And they found him not, because he was not," but he'd walked on up the King's Highway!



127 O God, let me be like Enoch! When the hour comes that I must take the path, let me find the King's Highway!

128 I can see Enoch. As he knowed it was becoming to him, for he was a prophet, and he knew what was going to happen. So, I can see him kiss his wife good-bye, and say, "Darling, I'll see you later." Take up his children, and kiss them good-bye; and go down to his married son and his married daughter, and kiss them good-bye.



129 They say, "Where you going, father? Are you going out for a little walk?"

227 I'll tell you what is certain, that's, the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Now, if you want



231 And Noah, which is a type, and we had that last

week in our lesson. Noah, the type of Israel that's carried over, will be over there on Mount Transfiguration, over there in—in Europe, down in Palestine, watching. And when they...When Noah saw Enoch was missing, he thought, "What become of Enoch? What become of Enoch? Where's he at?" Which, was a grandson. Noah was grandson to Enoch. And he said, "Where's it at? What become of him? We can't find

him no more." Noah started building on that ark. He knowed that the time was at hand, right then.



232 And now when the Church is taken up, and people say, "Well, I-I-I've called the police. I-I put out calls. She was sitting right at the table, and she vanished." Yeah. "I—I just don't know what become of her." Well, it's not only that. Well, police say, "We got-we got five hundred calls of that, this morning." What happened? It's over then, for you Gentiles. That's right. Watching.



233 The Word of God is certain. "Heavens and earth will pass away," Matthew 24:35, "but God's promises cannot fail." Jesus said, "All heavens and earth will pass away." \sim 13 \sim

You say, "Heavens?" Yeah. Ma-...

234 Revelation 21, John said, "I saw a new Heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and first earth was passed away; and there were no more sea. But it was prophesied to you, by the angels, Enoch, Noah, that I must come to fulfill every Word of God's Bible. I'm here as a witness in this 'land of the lost." And He preached to them.

On down into hell He went, right down to the doors of hell, knocked on the door. The devil opened the door, said, "I got You now."

145 Jerked them keys from his side, said, "You devil, you've held the bluff for a long time." Here it is, right here in the Bible. I get to it in a minute. "You've held the bluff for a long time, but I come to take over." Grabbed those keys and kicked him back in, and shut the door.

53 He said to Noah back there, that, as we're getting into this morning, "Why, it's going to rain." Why there wasn't...never was a cloud in the sky. The biggest stream of water was a branch where God irrigated the land, a little spring somewhere. That was the biggest stream of water there was.



54 Now, people say, "How in the world is there going to come any water down from up there? Show me where it's at up there in all that hot sun, if there ain't any up there."




55 "If God said, 'build an ark, that it's coming,' it's my business to build the ark and

get ready, 'cause it's coming. He's Jehovah-jireh, He can provide water up there."

56 And the only thing He done was let man, foolish, silly man, do exactly with his science, to bring to pass that what He knowed would come. God never destroyed the world; man destroys the world. God don't destroy nothing, God tries to preserve everything. Man destroys himself by his knowledge, like he did in the garden of Eden

at the tree, so forth. And so some fanatic got a hold of some atomic power, somewhere, that they had it.



57 They—they could work with it then, 'cause they could do things then with it that we

have never learned yet. We are not that far advanced. Maybe take three or four years yet, or more, 'fore we can do it, to do what they did. They built the pyramids and the sphinx and so forth. We could never do that. We couldn't reproduce that, there's no way for us to do it, only unless we can get an atomic power. Gasoline power, electric power, wouldn't lift one of them boulders, wouldn't move it off the ground. And some of them are a city block high, up in the air, and weighing a billion tons. How'd they get them up there? See, they knowed.



58 And they let that loose, somebody let one of them atomic bombs fly into the screen of some other's, back in the days. 'Cause, "As it was in the days of Noah, as it was, that kind of a civilization, that kind of a smart people; as it was in the days of Noah, so will it be, so will it be in the coming of the Son of man." A repeat of what it was! See?

59 Here not long ago they dug up a modern waterworks, was down-down here in

Mexico before the antediluvian flood. You seen it?



It was in the paper, where a modern waterworks just like we have now, that sunk so far beneath the ground; some atomic something covered it over. She just blew up and went over like that. See?

60 Now, "as it was in the days of Noah," smart men, smart men with their atomic powers and everything, could build pyramids and sphinx and so forth. "As it was in that day, so will it be." But the work's to be cut short in this day, 'cause there's to be a Raptured people taken out. Like Enoch, there's to be a people carried

over. We're in that class this morning, the people that's carried over like Noah was through the flood.



But remember, 61 before...Don't forget this! Before one drop of rain fell, before there was one thing in the sky, before Noah everever had the ark completed, Enoch was taken Home. Enoch was raptured without death, just started walking one day, and—and gravitation lost its hold on him. And he found one foot a little higher, and the other foot a little higher, and another foot a little higher, and first thing you know, he said,

"Farewell, world." Just walked on up into Glory.



62 And when Noah looked around and couldn't find Enoch anywhere, he looked around and he didn't know where Enoch went, then he said, "It's time to get to building the ark now." See? And he went to work on the ark to carry over the remnant.

63 That's the same thing that takes place right here. The Church was taken up into Heaven, and John now is brought up with It as a type of the resurrected, as we took it last night. And find out that this same Voice that summonsed him to look back

on earth, was the same Voice that summonsed him to come up.

64 Oh, every Christian! The very Voice, Charlie, that summoned you one day down there in Kentucky, to "Turn around," is the same Voice that'll summons you, "Come up!" Aren't you glad of that, Brother Evans? The Voice that said, "Turn around," the same Voice said, "Come up!" Oh, my! There, what a summons! What a reality! Clear, distinct like a trumpet,

"Turn around, serve Me! Come up to where I am."

166 Now, if you want to read in Matthew 18:16, It said, "There is three that bear record," see, in Saint...in First John 5:7, so forth. Three is always a witness. Is that right? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] It's а verification, something that's right. Three witnesses

bear. "In the mouth of two or three witness, let every word be established."




167 Now notice. We've had three witnesses. Three is a witness. Now, we have already had three raptures in the Old Testament. Did you know that? As a witness. Now watch. Enoch was one; Elijah was the other one; and Jesus was the other one.

Jesus, being the Keystone, now, He bare record. See? He was the Keystone between the Old and New Testament, 'cause He had to first die and then rapture. He died; come to

life and walked around here us; and then was with raptured up. Because, He was the Keystone that tied the two together. After His resurrection and rapture...Look. After He did that, and proved that, the Old Testament there. We all know Enoch was translated. We know Elijah was taken up by a whirlwind, that right, in a chariot of Fire. And Jesus died, buried, rose up and lived here on earth, and then was

raptured up, the Keystone. There is three, to bear record. Is that right?



168 Now, there has been one rapture already passed. You know that? That, let's see if we can't read it, right quick. Let's get Matthew, the 27th chapter. And let's get about the 45th verse of the Matthew, the 27th chapter. Let's see if we can't get that right quick, and see if-if we can't get just a little bit out of this, would help us, right quickly. 27:45, I believe, I got wrote down here. Let's read.

Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth...

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabach-...? which to say,...my God, why has thou forsaken me?

Some of them that stood by,...*heard* it, and *said, This man* calls...*Elias.*

And straightway one of them ran, and took a spunge, and filled it with vinegar, and *put it on a reed, and gave* it to *him to drink.*

The rest said,...let us see whether Elias will come and save him.

Jesus, when he had cried...with a loud voice, yielded up...

"A loud voice." Loud voice! Watch.

When Jesus, dying, screamed with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. ~ 10 ~

And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks did rent;

And the graves were opened; and many of the bodies...the saints that slept arose,

And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

169 One rapture is passed.

Three has happened in the Old Testament, of them prepared, who the Word of the Lord came to. See? The Word of the Lord came to Enoch. The Word of the Lord came to Elijah, His prophet. See? The Word of the Lord was Jesus. See?

170 Watch in the Old Testament, them Old Testament saints now, when this rapture first taken place. Notice verse 50. His loud voice awakened the Old Testament saints just exactly like the loud voice wakened Jesus...or wakened Lazarus. See? The loud voice awakened.

And the second is fulfilled in Second Thessalonians, the 4th chapter. Let's just take a read, read it. We just read, a few minutes ago. See?

...I would not have you...ignorant, brethren, concerning those...asleep, that you sorrow not, even...

That's First Thessalonians 4:12 to 18. That, that will be the second Rapture. The second Rapture will be the catching away of the Bride.

171 The Old Testament saints has gone into His Presence, paradise done away. And the Old Testament saints ascended up, at His loud voice, when He screamed and give up the ghost; because (why?) the ~ 14 ~

Sacrifice, the propitiation of their sins, that they had waited on, believing that perfect Lamb was coming. They had offered the Sacrifice, the Lamb. And when He died and yielded up the ghost, He screamed with a loud voice, and the Old Testament saints awoke.

Watch the shout and the voice over here, the same thing at His Coming. See?

"Yielded up the ghost." And when He did, the $\sim 15 \sim$

Sacrifice was perfect, and paradise emptied out. And the Old Testament saints came to the earth again, walked around on earth, and entered in with Him, at His rapture.

172 David said, over there, "Lift up, ye everlasting gates; and be ye lifted up." "He led captive captive, give gifts unto men," and the Old Testament saints went in with Him.

173 They said, "Who is this King of righteousness?"

174 "The Lord of Glory, mighty in host." Mighty host, here they come in, marching. "Jesus led captivity captive," and here He comes, the Old Testament with saints. And went in the new gates up There, and said, "Lift up, ye everlasting gates; and be ye lifted up; and let the King of Glory come in."

The voice come from the inside, said, "Who is the King of Glory?"

175 "The Lord mighty in battle." The gates flew open. "And Jesus, а Conqueror, led captive captive," them that had believed on Him, and the Word had come to them. There, the Old Testament saints laying in there, waiting, "He led captive captive; ascended on High," took the Old Testament saints and went in There is one Rapture, already passed.

176 The next Rapture takes place is (Second Thessalonians) for the Church, the Bride to be resurrected, to be raptured into Glory.
