'cause the jellyfish just lays there.




Brother, we need some Christians, not jellyfish, but with a backbone (That's right.) that'll stand.

It's your privilege to have anything that you inherited, through accepting Jesus Christ and dying to yourself. How marvelous. Yes, sir.





But you must get away from that, and act on God's Word, not what you feel, not what you see, what God said, and act on that. Make a confession of that.


"Confess" means "to say the same thing." And He's at the right hand of the Father with His Own Blood to make intercessions on your confession.



30 Why? We find out here that a daughter of Levi, or a son of Levi went and married a daughter of Levi. And this children—child was born, and


when it was born, they seen that it was a right kind of a child. Amen. I hope you get this.




How many times have I seen people like that in my day. And I've heard people

that take the argument and say, "Oh, it's such a blessed thing to be sick. God uses it to bless us." How can it be a bless and cursing the same time?





If you're more blessed when you're dead, and you can do more for the Lord



you're getting this: something now for this case.




That's the way in the meetings sometimes, say,


