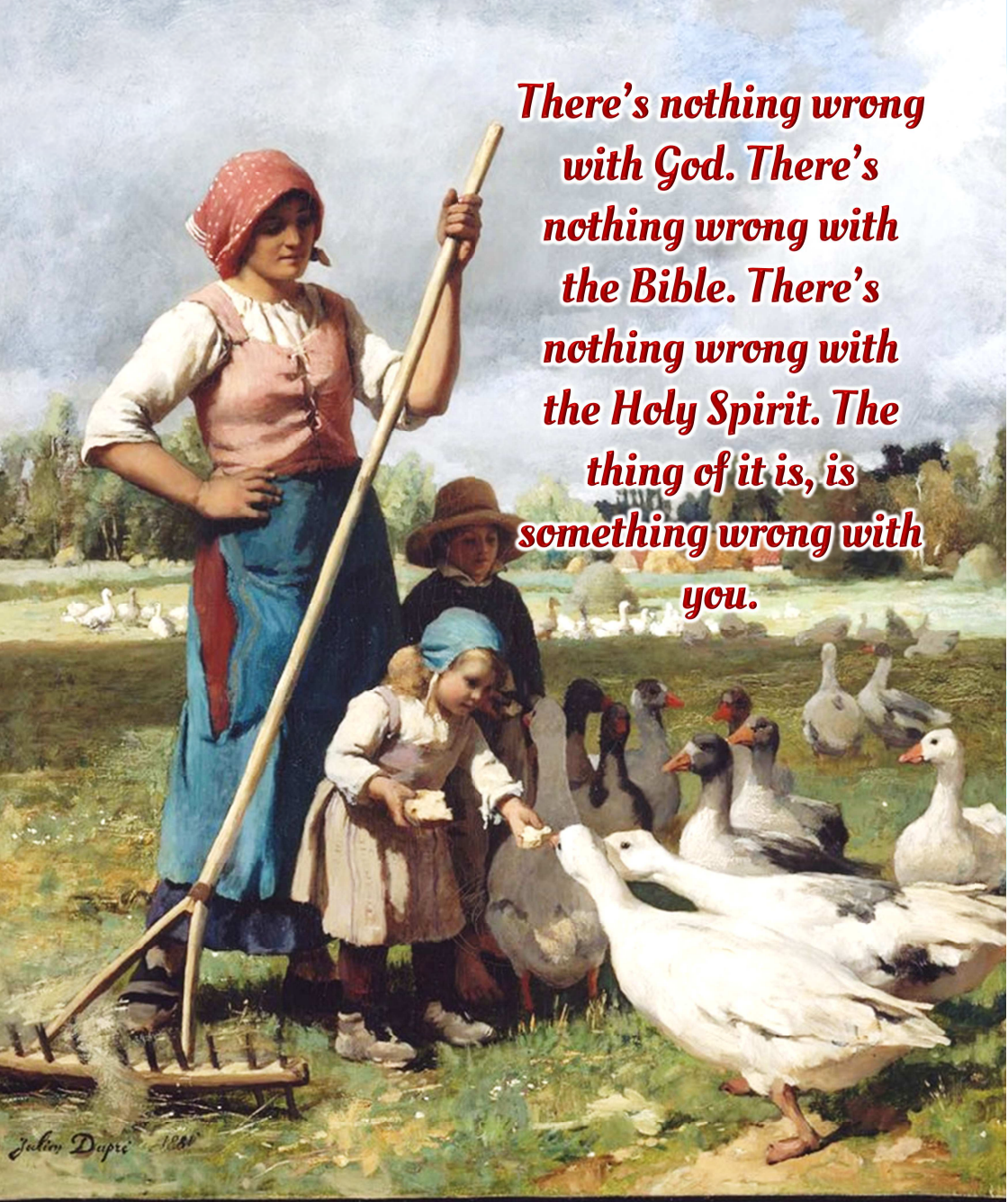

Here the other day, a little...I see so many people that come in, say, “Well Brother Branham, I was prayed for the...I—I—I really didn’t get any different. Well, there’s something wrong.” No, there’s not. **There’s nothing wrong with the system.** **There’s nothing wrong with God. There’s nothing wrong**

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with the Bible. There's nothing wrong with the Holy Spirit. The thing of it is, is something wrong with you.



33 Everything was running all right; it was just John. That's also...There was a lady came down the other day from—from Zion City; she may be here now...about a month ago. That little woman, her little husband, a beautiful little couple, and they came down to my place, and—and they come down with some good friends of mine, Simmses, from up there at Zion. And they may all be

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setting here tonight as far as I
know.



And she had a little baby; I
think it was born with its foot

hanging up like this and—and couldn't get its foot down. And—and she just said, "If I can only see Brother Branham put his hands on this baby, that foot will drop down." Why, she brought its shoes to wear home and everything. She...that's...Yes, sir.

34 So I was praying up at the Tabernacle at—or preaching, and then when I got through, I was trying to make a way to get out to another meeting and—or over

in Bloomington, Illinois. And then, the first thing you know, when I started to leave the platform, I believe we was going in to take footwashing.



We're...We believe in footwashing. I—I believe that the Bible teaches that. And we're supposed to do it until He comes. And so we try to keep every Word that He said. And we was observing this at our church, which we always have, for thirty years now.

We were going in for footwashing, and—and my son come up, and said, “Dad, there's—there's a people come from Zion there.” Said, “They was expecting to have

prayer for the sick tonight.” He said, “They got a little baby that, that woman believes if you’d ever pray for that baby, that little leg would drop down. It’s got a bad leg.”

I said, “Bring it here.” And the little, beautiful little mother.

She come up and she said, “My baby, Brother Branham. We have believe, husband and I, when you lay your hands on this baby, that the leg is going to come

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straight. It's going to be all right."



I said, "Do you require me to find a vision from the Lord?"

She said, “No, sir. Just lay your hands on her.”

35 And the next day I was out at the office. When I was setting out there and—and answering some calls, and—and doing some work there at the office. A car drove up and the little lady got out, her, and her husband. And here they come. Said, “Brother

Branham,” said—said,
“something went wrong.”

And I said, “Oh, what—
what do you mean?”

“Why,” she said, “the—the
baby’s leg’s not down yet.”

And I said, “Well, what’s
that got to do with it?”

And she said, “Well, I—I—I
believed, Brother Branham. I
believed if—if you’d ever lay
your hands on my baby that
God would heal it.” Said, “I
believed it.” And said,

“Something went wrong
somewhere.” She said,
“Maybe you’d better have a
vision for it.”

36 She said, “One thing I’ll ask, Brother Branham, do you think it’s God’s will for my baby to be crippled?”

And few days ago they called up. And now, the baby's leg's back normal. Come down. They...See, we just get a flusterated; that's all.

97 Now, you must believe what you ask for. If you are a believer, recognize yourself as a believer. Recognize that these things are for you.

98 If there's condemnation in your life, straighten that first. See? If you got condemnation in your...I...or you might have Oral Roberts and—and a dozen more

people who has faith to come here and pray over you, and jump up and down, and pour oil on you by the gallons, it—it still it—it won't move. That's right.



99 What falls off from Oral's meetings to that? I catch them in the prayer line. You hear Him say, "You was prayed for before. A man with dark hair, kind of big fellow, big jaw." That's Oral Roberts. See? "And that was at a certain city; called certain, certain thing."

100 "Yes, that's right." See?

101 "You was prayed for by such-and-such a man." See, like that. "But here it is.

Here is your trouble.” See?
“Go make that thing right. Go
out there and confess that sin
to your husband, to your wife.
Go do this thing.” It’ll never do
you any good, no matter who
you pray for, till you make that
right. Condemnation’s in your
heart, and God will not come
into that heart condemned.
See? God don’t dwell in that;
you got to make it right. Then
when you do, you must have
faith. If everything’s right, you

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must have faith and believe it.
Don't be 'fraid.



102 In the Book of Job, It
says here, “Job feared.” And
what he feared, it actually

happened. What brought it? His fear. That's what made it happen. His faith would have kept him from it, but his fear brought him...brought it to him. He was scared it was going to happen, and it did happen. Now, if been—he knowed it wouldn't happen, it wouldn't happen. See what I mean?

103 If you're afraid when you come by the prayer line, "Maybe I just haven't got the

faith sufficient"; it'll never happen, don't worry. See?



But if you know it's going to happen, it'll happen. See? See, it's a substance of

something. Job had a fear that these things would come upon him, and they did. If you have a fear that your disease is going to leave you...or won't leave you, it won't. If you have a faith, that it will.



104 You ask any medical doctor. The first thing he'll try to get you to do, is to have confidence in the medicine he's giving you. If you haven't got no confidence in it, you better leave it alone. See? Sure! What is it then? It's faith that does the healing; it's faith that does it all the time.

105 Peter, he was doing all right till he got scared. The Word told him, he could walk on the water. He was scared first, he thought it was a—a

ghost, and he said, “Lord, if it be You, bid me come to You on the water.”



106 Said, “Come on.”
Now, that’s just the same as
James 5:14, same as Mark
16. The same God said It,
said, “Come on.” And so he

started walking. He done all right, got down out of the ship, started walking on...



107 There was a storm on the sea, you know; great,

whitecap waves, bigger than these hills around here, the foam breaking on top of them; terrific, maybe fifteen, twenty feet foam, the whitecaps breaking. And that was a terrific thing for him to ask, “If it be You, Lord,...” See, He looked like a...there looked like a shadow or a spirit. He said, “If it’s You, bid me come to You on the water.”

108 Jesus said, “Come on.”



109 And he stepped down, said, “It’s the Lord, I’ll just walk.” But when he got his eyes on the waves, he got scared. What come in his mind? First thing, he...“I’m going to walk because the

Word said for me to walk.” And the next thing, he looked at his...well, he looked at his symptoms; he looked out there and seen how big them waves was, and he got scared; and when he did, down he went. See? What he feared, happened! What he believed, happened! When he believed he could walk, he walked; when he believed and got scared, in his belief, then his substance left him. See? He still professed his faith, but

he didn't have the substance. The substance would have went right over top of that whitecap and went right on to Him, see, if he has the Perfect Faith. See? But he didn't have it. He thought he did. He did at first, he was willing to venture right out, "Why, the Lord told me to do it, it's got to happen." So he just steps right down out of the boat, and takes off. He never thought about the—the—the waves, how

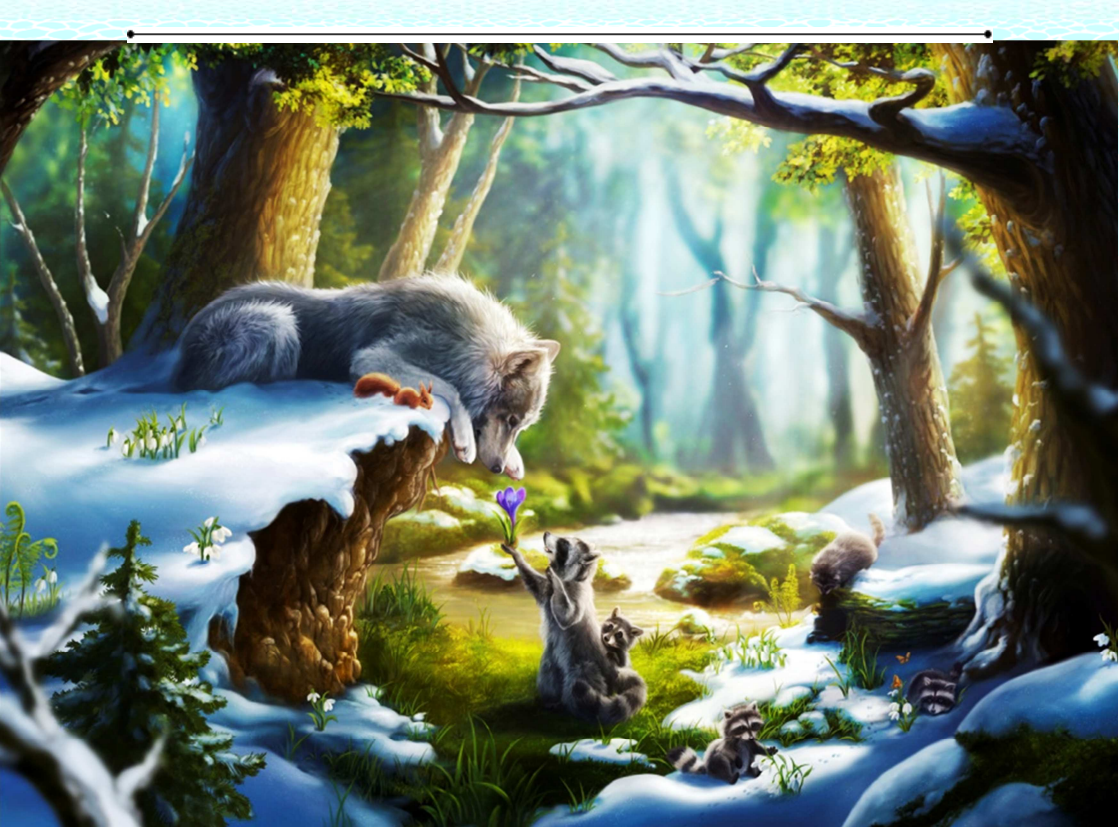
contrary they was. He never got that in his mind.



110 Now, when you get to thinking, “Well, now wait. And,

you know, I've been sick so long, I..." Stop! You just might as well go back to the boat. See? See? But when you quit thinking about that,...

119 But give God's Word the first place. A man can't even come to...He can't sin...Hallelujah! Here it is. This is coming, fresh. A man cannot sin until first he casts aside God's Word. He can't even sin, that's "disbelieve," until first he gets rid of the

Word of God, the Presence of
God, he cannot sin.



120 Eve could not sin until
she laid aside God's Word,

opening up her channel of reasons through her soul, and begin to reason. “Why, certainly. My husband has never told me these things, but I believe that you...He told me I shouldn’t do this, but, you know, you make it so real and so plain. I—I believe it would be wonderful, because you’re making it so plain to me.” See, there was the first battle. And, through that battle, has caused every other war. And every bloodshed that

ever come, was caused right there at Eden. She disbelieved God's Word.



121 And if one little iota of God's Word was disbelieved,

caused all this trouble, how we going to get back, disbelieving the Word? You can't do it. Got to shut off all these other things, conscience, memories, and say...reasonings, and all these other things. "Casting down reasonings." We don't reason about it, at all, nothing at all.

122 We just accept the Word upon the basis, "God said so," and sets a stream between you and God. Every

channel comes open between
you and God, then.



123 There's the battle, the
very first, front line. Let's not

use a .22 rifle; let's get a—an atomic bomb. Let's do the job right. Let's get God's atomic bomb. "What is it, Brother Branham?" F-a-i-t-h in His Word. That's God's atomic bomb. It blows sickness and devils, right and left. It—it annihilates them. Discriminates...Oh, it's...It just destroys. It disintegrates everything that's ungodly. When that bomb of faith drops in there, with the Word of God behind it, it blows every devil,

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every sickness, every
disease.



124 You say, “Is that right,
Brother Branham? Then why

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does it, on some, and not on others?”



125 It's because of the channel. You can look out and see it. But you've got to have

it in here, looking this a way. Not out there, looking in; you got to be in, looking out. See? You can't come through reason. You can't come through these other things. You've got to come right down God's channel of it, right into the soul. And how do you do it? What's the last channel?

126 It'll reas-...right on down. You say, senses, "Oh, I—I can feel it. Yeah, there it is. Uh-huh. Oh, I—I might smell it, or so forth. These

things are there. Yeah.” Next thing, you reason, “Well, it looks like he ought to know what he’s talking about. The doctor says I can’t get well. That ought to be.” You see, right there you’re—you’re wrong. That’s the devil standing there. That’s the devil poking these things into you. Don’t you believe it.

127 “Hallelujah! God’s Word said I’ll...‘Above all things, I would that you prosper in health.’ That’s

right.” How can you be a real soldier out there? See, “I want you to prosper in health.””

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
