146 Let's stand up on our feet, everybody. Cry, Pentecostal, raise up your hands, "Once more, Lord! Once more, Lord, once more!" Hallelujah! I don't know what to do, but It's here. Let's cry, with one accord, "Once more, Lord!" Cry it out, "Once more, Lord! Once more, Lord! Once more, Lord, send Your Power, send Your blessings. Send the Holy Ghost upon us, like a rushing mighty wind, and fill every soul that's in here,

anew." Glory to God! Believe it with all your heart. "Once more, Lord, once more!" Hallelujah!

147 Drunk on the Spirit! If the Holy Ghost can just pour into you till you're so drunk you forget what your name is, till you forget all your doubts; get you so drunk on the Spirit till you forget your doubts, amen, then you can get somewhere with God. Then the cry, "once more," goes up from the sincerity, and then

another one. Hallelujah! Filled with the Holy Ghost, these drunk on the Spirit; God's righteousness and holiness, and power, get you so drunk till you forget who you are. You're nothing, to begin with. Remember, God wants to come into you. "Once more, Lord, once more! Once more, Lord, once more!"

148 Oh, Pentecostal, Pentecostal, run for your life! There is just a little time left. It's later than you think. If I

never say another word from this pulpit, remember, run for your life! It's later than you think. I feel the Holy Spirit on me, saying, "Say it again." Run for your life! It's later than you think.

149 Once more, Lord, once more fill Life Tabernacle with Eternal Life, every member in here. And let the Glory of the Lord fall upon this congregation, Lord Jesus. Hallelujah! Hallelujah! I believe God. Once more,

Lord, once more let man forget who they are. Let man forget his unbelief, that we could cry, "Once more, Lord, once more!"

50 Now, the Jews thought that they were worshiping in the true Light. They thought they were worshiping, this same God that they were turning down. The very one that they thought that they

were worshiping, they were crucifying. They were making fun of the very God, and making Him a laughingstock of the people, the very God that they thought they were worshiping.

51 May I say this with reverence and respect, but to bring Light, because, as our brother said a while ago, we're living later than you think we are. One of these days something is going to happen, it's going to be too

late. The people will take on the mark of the beast, not even knowing what they're doing. "Blind lead the blind, they all fall in the ditch," Jesus said. And we're living later than we think. Many honest people follow that, not even knowing what they're doing.

52 But the hour is at hand now when the Light is shining, the Gospel Light, in Its power of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, manifesting Himself that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. He lotted that for this day. The things that He promised for this day must happen in this day. If the church won't accept It, God is able of these stones to rise children unto Abraham. He'll get His Message over, because He's always done it. He always will do it.

82 Now, ten is a bad number. But man always counts backwards, starts at ten. "Ten, nine, eight, seven, six, five, four, three, two, one, zero."

83 What does God do? He starts with His number, seven. That's God's number. Watch Him, seven. Oh, He counts ahead, starting with one. He starts with His first church age. That's what His symbols was on earth. There is seven church ages. He made the

world in seven days; seventh day He rested. That's His last number in His creation. He rested.

84 Notice, He counts straight ahead, not backwards. He goes forward. He starts from His first church age, which begin at a.d. 33, and He started the countdown. He counted His church ages. That was the birth of the Church, on the Day of Pentecost. What did...He starts counting. He

starts counting the church ages. "First one, was Ephesus, number one; two, Smyrna; three, Pergamos; four, Thyatira; five, Sardis; six, Philadelphia; seven, Laodicea." It's later than you think. It's later than you think. The counting is over. The next thing is "zero," let's go. Everything is ready. The counting is over.

85 When John Glenn, our astronaut, got into that big tube, to take off, the nation

stood speechless. They didn't know, that morning that he took off. When he did, he got in the tube, and everybody was crying, and waiting, and watching what was going to happen. The nation stood spellbound. You seen the...All the televisions blaring, and everything, so everybody could see it. There natural eye couldn't see it, because they put it on television. You remember it.

86 Then when he got placed up in the tube just right, and when he did, they started, "Ten, nine, eight, seven, six, five, four, three, two, one, zero," off he went. What happened? When the big lever pull, the atomics begin to catch fire, begin to break, fire begin to fly, smoke begin to roll, and the great big tube took off for the air, into the unknown, out yonder somewhere. He took off in the man's achievement, the

greatest he's ever had. But let me tell you, that's just a very small thing.

87 One of these mornings, God's achievement, of His astronauts that's climbed into Jesus Christ, been born in there by the Holy Ghost, filled with His power! One of these mornings, the whole universe will be screaming, and wailing and gnashing of teeth, when they see they've missed it. When the great Eagle, powered by the Holy Ghost

and Fire, begins to spread Her wings, the astronauts will take off into the sky, to go to meet the Bridegroom; when the Bride takes off, in the astronaut power of God Almighty Who sent Jesus Christ to the earth, in the form of the Holy Ghost, has brought the Church through these achievements!

88 Until, now She is getting resurrected Power in her, to fly beyond the things of the world, seeing Him in out here

in the Church, making Himself the same yesterday, today, and forever. Yes, sir. The countdown is even over. Every church age has done passed. We're ending on the Laodicea.

215 We find, Elijah kept looking until he seen just the size of a man's hand.

216 Now, unbelief would have caught that right quick.

"If that's the best you can do?" See? "If that's all you can do, well, take it back."

217 But what was it? He was looking for the supernatural. Oh, he knowed only the hand of God could do it. And when he saw that hand, J-e-s-u-s, he had f-a-i-th. Yes. And when he saw it, he said, "I hear the sound of abundance of rain." What was it? He accepted the first move.

218 Oh, unbeliever, this morning, you who have been

all scrupled up in your water baptisms and everything else, let the Spirit of God open your eyes and show you just a little something, then you start from there. "I hear the sound of abundance of rain." You who believe creeds instead of the Word, come back to the Word, just see the first little move. Faith accepted it. "There is what I'm looking for."

219 We're looking for the Coming of the Lord. We look at the Holy Ghost falling in the

last days. We look at signs and wonders. We watch what's taking place. See? Don't you see? What you looking at? That's exactly what God said would take place. Let faith grab it, say, "I want it, too."

220 Watch Elijah. When he accepted it, you know his life must have been renewed. He outrun Ahab's chariot. He run before the chariot, when he couldn't even climb the hill. He run before those swift horses.

"Get the rain barrels out. I hear the sound of abundance of rain." The first little move, "Glory!"

221 The first little move at the pool of Bethesda, they rushed to get to It. Amen.

222 Oh, if the people here, if you haven't received the Holy Ghost this morning, if that first little tinkle would say, "That's the Truth. That man is telling the Word that's the Truth," then hurry as quick as you can. Don't wait. What you

looking at? What you waiting for? The hour is later than you think. Get moving towards It, as fast as you can. Why? When Elijah saw that move, it was the evidence of an answered prayer.

223 O God, I wish that every sick person here this morning, that feels this Holy Spirit in our presence now, could realize that. That's the evidence of a prayer that you prayed, has been answered in the Presence of God. Every

man who wants the baptism of the Holy Ghost, if you'd feel that little grand feeling, saying that, "I believe that's the Truth"; if you'd take that, "That's the evidence of my answered prayer"; raise up your hands and say, "God, I receive It now," something would take place. Depends on...

224 God throws the signs all around us, and we still move right on, just out of the way of it. Yeah. Oh, my!

Elijah knowed it was an answer of prayer.
