


cloud, and lightning struck the casket and blowed him plum out of the casket.

393 He has a spirit in him, a man does when he's born, because it's a spirit of nature. It's a spirit of the world, it's a spirit of the—the god of this world. He is merely an offspring of Adam.

394 A tree reproduces itself. Vegetation reproduces itself. Animals reproduce themselves. Humans reproduce themselves. They are the by-product of original creation. Get it?

395 Now, now when a man is borned, he's borned with a spirit in him of this world. That's the reason he has to be borned again. For this spirit come from the conception by father and mother, which was the sexual conception, and absolutely could not live forever. So he's got to be borned again. And before he could do that, God had to come down and make a way for him to be borned again; because he had no way to redeem himself, he was without hope. He didn't...without hope, without God, without Christ, in the world, lost and gone. He-he...there's nothing he could do to save himself.

He...every...No matter if he was a high priest, if he was a bishop, if he was a pope, whatever he was, he's just as guilty as the next man.

396 So, it had to take One that was not guilty, to do it. And the only One that wasn't guilty was God Himself. And God had to come down and become man (and He came in the form of Christ) to anchor the stinger of death, to take the sting of death out, to redeem us, that we...not by our works or by our goodness (we have none), but by His grace, to be saved. Then we receive of His Life into this mortal body, and now we are sons and daughters of God, and have Eternal

Life within us. We are sons and daughters of God. Therefore, Jesus, being alive...

397 And no man, no matter how wicked or how good, when he has to...when he leaves this earth, he's not dead. He's somewhere else. But he has a life that will perish, after he's punished in hell for his deeds, he...but yet that life has to cease. There's only one type of Eternal life.

398 Now, we've been through that. If a man can be a sinner and be punished forever...He can't be punished forever 'less he's got Eternal Life. If he's got Eternal Life, he's

saved. See? So there's only one type of Eternal Life, and that's the *Zoe*, "the Life of God." And he can't perish.

399 But the wicked are in a place of—of waiting (in torment) for their judgment (to be judged according to the deeds done in the body) at the last day. Now, but we...Some man's sins go before them, some follow after them.

400 Now if we confess our sins, He's just to forgive us, therefore we'll never have to stand the judgment of God. You get it? Look, Romans 8:1, "There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in

Christ Jesus." That are IN Christ. That's passed from death unto Life; see, we have no condemnation and was in Christ Jesus. "That walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit." See? "He that heareth My Words, believeth on Him that sent Me, has Eternal Life."

401 And if I've been accepted in Christ, and Christ took my judgment, and I accepted His propitiation for my sins, how can God judge me? He's done judged me, when He judged Christ. Then I'm free from judgment. "Then when I see the Blood, I'll pass over you." See?

402 But, now, the wicked is not so. He goes into a place of torment. And we know that that's true. The wicked is alive. He's in a place of torment. He's place where he know...That's how these spiritualists and mediums call up these spirits of the people that's gone on, some kind of frolic and dirty jokes and things they crack, if you've ever seen any of it. All right. Why? They don't...

403 Look at this Miss Piper, before my article went of *The Miracle of Donny Morton*. How many read that article? Yes, many of you did, sure. And it's in *Reader's Digest*. Did you notice? Just before that, went forth

Miss Piper, the greatest spiritualist the world has ever knowed. Twelve pages given to her story. And for fifty years...They've had her all over the world, and scientific proof and everything, that "she absolutely talks with the dead, and the people come up." What? God's Name wasn't mentioned one time, no repentance, no Divine healing, nothing about It, see.

404 Only thing it was, was those people mentioned, "John, don't you know me? I'm George that was at a certain place, and I did so-and-so and so-and-so. You remember that place we went and done this?" See, that's

all they know. They're gone. Past from...They're—they're nothing left but judgment.

405 The way the tree leans, that's the way it falls. And the state you die...That's the reason I differ with praying for the dead, see, the intercession of prayers or—or communion of saints and so forth. It cannot be, according to God's Word. It does no good to pray for anybody after they're gone. They're finished. They're...they've...They passed the line between mercy and judgment. They either went to mercy, or went away from mercy. Jesus said so, in 16th chapter of Saint Matthew, HeHe—He taught it; 16th chapter of Mark, I believe it is. The rich man and Lazarus; no man can cross over this gulf, and never will cross over! There you are. See? So it settles it.

406 Now, but when Christ died, everything had to witness that He was the Christ. Now let's go to your question. The first thing, the stars refused to shine, the sun went down, the moon wouldn't give its light, the earth belched its rocks at His death. And He went and preached to the souls that were in prison, that repented not in the longsuffering of the days of Noah. He, they had to recognize. Look at that! And if there

by chance be a sinner here tonight, think that over a minute. Someday this Gospel that you're hearing preached right now, you'll have to witness by It. Somewhere you'll bow your knee, regardless of who you are. It may be ten thousand years from today, it may not be until the...in the morning. Whenever it is, you're going to bow somewhere, and you're going to hear this same Gospel preached right back to you.

407 For after those souls were in prison, that repented not when Enoch and when all of them preached, and Noah...and for the longsuffering of God, like it is now, waiting for that time

to come. And Noah and Enoch and all of them preached, and those people laughed and made fun of them. And they were in the prison house, and Jesus went and preached to the souls that were in prison. He witnessed! The heavens witnessed He was, the earth witnessed He was, hell witnessed He was!

408 The Bible said that it...David, many years ago, in the Psalms...All right, Brother, you read the Psalms, if you will there. Psalms 16:10. [Brother Neville reads the Scripture—Ed.]

[For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.]

409 Read the same thing, brother, in where Peter preached, on Acts, the 2nd chapter, the 27th verse. [Brother Stricker reads the Scripture—Ed.]

[Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.]

410 Read two verses above it, brother, so you can get the context of it.

[For David speaketh concerning Him, I foresaw the Lord always before

my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:]

[Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:]

[Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.]

411 Read the next verse now.

[Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance.]

412 Yes, notice. Now, my Jehovah Witness friend, I'd like to ask you about that. See? If hell is a place,

Hades, Sheol, whatever you wish to call it, if that ceases at the grave, then why did He say, "I'll not leave My soul in hell, neither will I suffer Thy Holy One to see corruption"? How about that? See?

413 Here His body was, in the grave; and His soul was in hell, preaching, alive! What about that? He was in His theophany again. His soul was down there with those people that were in theophany also. And was witnessing to them, that they "repented not in the longsuffering."

414 He...In other words, He'd knocked at the door. And when the

door swung open, and all those souls that repented, He said, "I'm the Seed of the woman. I'm the One that Enoch here..." Over in Paradise, another place. Don't never lose them three places, now: the place of the wicked, the place of the righteous, and hell itself. See?

415 Just like a trinity of Heaven, like: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Like the trinity of the beast: the false prophet, the beast, and the—and the mark of the beast. And all that, remember, it's all in trinity. Trinity makes one, perfected. One is perfected. You're perfected, one in three: soul, body, and spirit; water,

blood, and nerves. See, whatever you were, you have to take three to make a perfected one. Take a three-cornered piece of glass and put the sun on it, you got a perfected rainbow. See, everything, you have to have three to make a perfect one.

416 And now, remember that, when He died, He went first and preached to the souls that wasn't in prison...that was in prison, and witnessed that He was "the Seed of the woman." He was "the One that Enoch saw coming with ten thousands of His saints." He had to witness the Scriptures that had been preached by Noah, and by Enoch, and by the

righteous, that "He was that One." Everything had to recognize It!

417 Then He descended into hell, and received the keys of death and hell from the devil.

418 Come back up into Paradise, and brought Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and the righteous, and raised, Matthew 27, and they come out of the grave and entered into the city, and appeared to the people along the street. Hallelujah! There you are!

419 Now, but His body...While His soul was over here witnessing to the lost, down here taking the keys from the devil, and coming back and

bringing Abraham and Isaac; His soul was laying in the...His soul was down there doing it, and His body was laying in the grave. That's the reason Jesus said...People say, "Well, why does Jesus say, 'Three days, I'll raise it up, three days I'll raise'? He—He died on Friday afternoon, raised up on Sunday morning."

days," if you'd get the lexicon. For He knew that David, under the anointing (of the anointing of the Holy Spirit), said, "I will not suffer My Holy One to see corruption." He knowed that pertained to Him. He knowed that meant Him. He was God's Holy One,

and He knew that corruption sets in in seventy-two hours. Somewhere within them three days, He was coming out of there again, because the Scriptures cannot be broken.

421 And every promise in There pertains to me and pertains to you, it's ours!

422 He said, "You destroy this body, and I'll raise it up in three days." For He said, "I'll not leave My soul in hell, neither will I suffer My Holy One to see corruption."

423 He knowed, in three days that body was coming out of there. He didn't stay the three full days. No, sir,


He certainly did not. He stayed just from Friday afternoon until Sunday morning, not one cell of that body could be corrupted.

424 And He was dead, and embalmed, and was laying...or wrapped in cloth, and laid into a tomb. In that hot, boggy country, just take a few hours and He go to corrupting. You go to morti-...mortifying, you know, his body, his nose dropping in and things, corruption sets in; that hot, damp country. And it would've went to corrupting, because it was a body. But He knowed, before that cell corrupted, that God said through David the

prophet, "I'll not suffer My Holy One to see corruption."

425 How He took the Word of God and lived by It! Now, every one of them promises in there that pertained to Him, God fulfilled every one of them. And every promise that pertains to the believer, God will fulfill every promise of It. Amen. Just rest assure that It's the Truth. Amen. So, His soul...

Said, "She's been dead about three minutes." Said, "She screamed as hard as she could, for you." Said, "I got a message for you."

Said, "What?"

249 Said, "Tell that preacher, that I said that about, 'Please forgive me.'"

250 I went down there to look at her. Beautiful woman; and she had suffered so hard. She had little freckles across her nose; a pretty woman. And the freckles, looked like, stood out. And her eyes had pushed completely out of the sockets, and was halfway turned back. Course, her bowels and kidneys had moved, and the steam coming up all over the bed, like that.

251 And her husband looked at me, said, "Brother Branham, say a prayer, 'cause she wanted to see you."

I said, "A prayer for her now would do no good."


252 "The way the tree leans, that's the way it falls." See? "Be not deceived; God is not mocked.

23 "There is a great gulf betwixt you and he, that no man has ever crossed, or ever will cross." See? When you—when you die, that settles it. I know people claim that they pray you back out of those places, but don't you never believe it. That's contrary to the Word of



49 Say, here is a line like this. And in here there's all mortals. On this side, or that side, men are influenced by one side. This side comes from God. This side comes from the devil. Now, let's just take it a great conglomeration of blackness, and gaiety, and muck, and sin, and divisiveness of this world. Every once in a while, you'll see a little white spot; that's a Christian, like a light. Now, those that are in darkness are influenced from beneath. Those that

are lights are influenced from above. Now, when you leave either one of these channels, you go into the realm of spirit. This is the mortal realm, the dimensions that we live in.

Now, if you go this a way...Listen close. If you go this a way, the first dimension is the spirits of the dead. Peter spoke of it: "in prison, that repented not by long suffering in the days of Noah." The wicked unregenerated man, when he dies, his spirit goes into this realm.

The next realm below that is demons. The next realm below that is

hell. I'm giving you a parable so you see it.

50 Now, what happened to that woman? She broke into that realm, to the people that absolutely are dead in sin and trespasses, and that's all they know about is the way the tree leans, that's the way it falls. And there she broke into that realm, talking to the spirits of the dead.

Now, going this a way, the first thing is the spirit of a man that died and rose again, Christ, the Holy Spirit. That's what influences the believer, going upward.

The next is angelic beings. The next is heaven itself, the third heaven. Amen. Oh, my. I see something, glorious. When Jesus died yonder at Calvary for a propitiation for our sins, he died not a just man but a sinner, not of His own, but mine and your sins sent Him to the regions of the lost. And I can see Him when He died yonder on Calvary, hanging between the malefactors, crying, "My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?" And when He gave up the ghost and bowed His head, His Spirit went and preached to the spirits that were in prison, that repented not in the longsuffering of the days of Noah. The Scripture says so.

51 I can see Him go up to the regions of the lost, to a door. [Brother Branham makes a knocking sound— Ed.] And He opened the door. They begin screaming and wailing, those souls that repented not. He said, "You're of Enoch, I am He, that Enoch had a spiritual revelation of. I am He, that was preached before the antediluvian world, 'The Lord shall descend with ten thousands of His saints.' I'm the virgin born Son of God. And I've died at Calvary to redeem the lost. Why didn't you accept Enoch's

message under the burnt offering? And the door was closed with a weeping and howling and gnashing of teeth. On down the road, demons, He got to the very door of hell [Brother Branham knocks—Ed.], knocked at the door. The devil opened the door, said, "Well, You finally arrived did You?" But He said, "Just a minute. I am the virgin born Son of God. The price has been paid. My Blood's still wet on Calvary's cross. You can't bluff the people any more. I come to take over." Amen. See Him reach over there and jerk the keys off of his side, hang them on His own side. Getting

near daylight, He's going back. And He just starts up.

53 Remember, there's some more people that had a revelation: Job, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, all those in paradise couldn't go into the presence of His majesty, because the blood of bulls and goats wouldn't take away sin; it only covered it. But now they can go. The real sacrifice, the very predominating Son of the living God, the Son of the morning, had come and died, and the Blood of God, Himself, had paid the price. Hallelujah! Oh, I feel religious.

Notice. I can see Him knock at the door. Abraham and Sarah was setting back in there, Job and all of them, saying, "You know, I believe something took place up on earth a while ago." I can hear Him knock at the door, and they open up the door; Abraham said, "Sarah, looky here. Here He is Here's the Lamb that's been slain from the foundation of the world."

I can hear Daniel look out and say, "Wait a minute. That's the Stone I seen cut out of the mountain without hands." I can hear Ezekiel saying, "I saw Him like clouds under His feet, when He was coming."

I can hear Job said, "I know My Redeemer liveth and there He stands." Hallelujah.

54 The patriarchs and prophets a answering to Him...I can hear Him say, "Get ready, children. You've died under a good faith. You come God's provided way. And I've made a way now. You're going back to receive your immortal bodies. Just a few minutes it's going be daylight, and we've got to appear on earth.

I hear Abraham say, "Master, can we make a little whistle stop? I'd like to look around the old city and see how it looks."

Daniel say, "I'd like to go out where I saw the visions."

He said, "Sure. I'm going to be there for several days, talking to My disciples and instructing them and—concerning the things of the Kingdom of God. I've got to anoint them, and the Holy Spirit's a coming...Tell them to preach the Gospel and heal the sick to all the world."

I can hear the Old Testament saints, acquainted with David's prophecy said, "Lift up ye everlasting gates, and be ye lifted up, let the King of Glory come in."


I can hear the Angels behind, said, "Who is this King of Glory?"

138 You know, twenty-three years ago, I settled that. I been happy ever since. I told the Lord I—I didn't want any trouble at the river. Each day I take inventory of myself. I don't want any trouble.

139 It's going to be awful on that morning: all the screams and cries that you ever hear; rich man throwing their money in the streets; rainbows flicker in the skies; lightning flashing; thunders roaring; the moon turning into blood, and dripping out like dark blood falling; the sun refusing to shine; the rocks roaring; atoms exploding everywhere; fire falling. Huh-uh. I don't want no trouble then. I want to be sure of it. I want to make sure right now, 'cause, you know, this might be the last hour that I'll be here, or you, either one. It's all over

then. Way the tree leans, that's the way it falls.

140 Would there be another, just before we close now and have prayer? You know, God knows your heart. Don't trust in theology. Don't trust in head knowledge. If you haven't had a real experience with God, and know that you've passed from death to Life, that Divine love of God reigns in your heart, don't take any chance on it, friend. 


