

34 And after making my own consecration, and after making, having the church to do so. Now, if God blessed us the way He has in the last few meetings, with that little consecration, what will He do if we keep it up? See? Just keep it up. Now listen. You're in love with one another. How I seen you standing in the aisles, this morning, and this week, with your hands to God, and—and the lovely Spirit moving around, over you!

35 Now don't you listen to one foul thing the devil has got to say. See? If the devil shows you some, or tells you something evil, about one of the members of the Body of Christ, don't you believe it. For, as soon as you believe it, you mar your experience.

36 And if you see one of the members of the Body of Christ doing something evil, don't tell nobody else. But go to that member, and with love, and see if you can't bring them back to

Christ again. And if you can't do it, then tell one person, or let them go with you. Do it the way the Scripture says. See? But don't...

37 If somebody says, "Sister So-and-so, or Brother So-and-so," don't you believe one word of it. You just leave it go. Because, remember, it's the devil trying to tear you to pieces. Now just look for him to come in, 'cause he'll do it. Now you let the good man of the house, faith,

stand right there, and don't you receive one thing. These people have been set in Heavenly places with you, fellowship together around the blessings of God, taking the communion at the table, and the Holy Spirit has witnessed that they are the children of God. Let's just be real sweet, kindhearted, forgiving, loving. And if the other person talks evil against you, you talk sweet against them. Watch how sweeter comes to you then. See? That's right. Just

always return good for evil, love for hate. And just...

72 That road to Damascus changed Paul. Going down, about eleven o'clock, perhaps, in a day, that he was stricken down. And he heard a Voice, saying, "Saul, why pe<mark>rsecutest thou</mark> Me?" And he looked up. And looking up, being a Jew, and knowed that Pillar of Fire was the Lord that led the children of Israel, because he knew that's what It was.

73 Remember, this Hebrew would have never called anything "Lord," capital L-o-r-d, Elohim, unless he had been satisfied that that's what It was, because he was trained scholar. And when he looked up, and he seen This, a Light, a Pillar of Fire that had led his people through the wilderness, and he said, "Lord," Elohim, capital L-o-r-... "Lord, Who are You?"

74 And what a surprise it must have been to this theologian, to say, "I'm Jesus," the very One that he was so against. What a what a turnaround! Oh! Oh! It must have been something terrific for this man, that all of his ambitions that he had, to find out, all at once, he had been persecuting. His ambitions had drove him to—to farther away from the main thing that he meant to do. And what a-a great shock it must have been, for this apostle, when He said, "I

am Jesus," the very One that he was persecuting. "Why persecutest thou Me?"

75 Another little quotation we might drop in here. You see, as they make fun of the Church, they're not really making fun of the Church, they are making fun of Jesus. "Why persecutest thou Me?" How could Paul then, with all his intellect, believe that This was...that this Group that he was persecuting was the very God that he claimed to be serving? I

think that's, without going into details, I think we're all well trained enough to know what I mean here. The same thing is happening today.



83 And you say, "Divine healing?" Sure! My Spirit come from a place where the Divine Healer is. We're from a land of Divine healing. Amen!

84 Say, "You believe that God is." Sure, it's from the land where

God is. And we're pilgrims and strangers like Abraham and Isaac. When just the—the overshadowing of the Holy Spirit hit them, they went through the land and confessed that they were pilgrims and strangers. They were seeking a City whose Builder and Maker was God. And now, after we've got the Evidence of it living in us, how much more should we be pilgrims and strangers, walking through the world, turning our head from the evil

things, because we are of another nation, another people.

Certainly!

85 Now watch the evil controls of this world now, as we read from Ezekiel 28:12.

Son of man, take up a lamentation unto the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD;... (Now watch; He's speaking to the spirit in the king. See?)...Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sun, full of wisdom,...perfect

in beauty. (Satan, see there how Satan was the most beautiful of the archangels?)

Thou hast been in Eden...

86 Now you know the King of Tyrus at that time could not have been in Eden, for it was four thousand years before that. See? "Thou has been in Eden," who's He talking to? He's talking to Satan in that king. Hallelujah! Brother, I feel religious. When...

87 And then, what's these people going to do that blasphemes and makes fun of people under the demonstration of the Holy Ghost? When they make fun of those people they are blaspheming the Holy Ghost is absolutely which unpardonable. You're not talking to that man, you're talking to the Spirit that's moving in that man. We ought to honor one another, and love one another, and exhort one another, talk

good of each other. That's what we should do.
