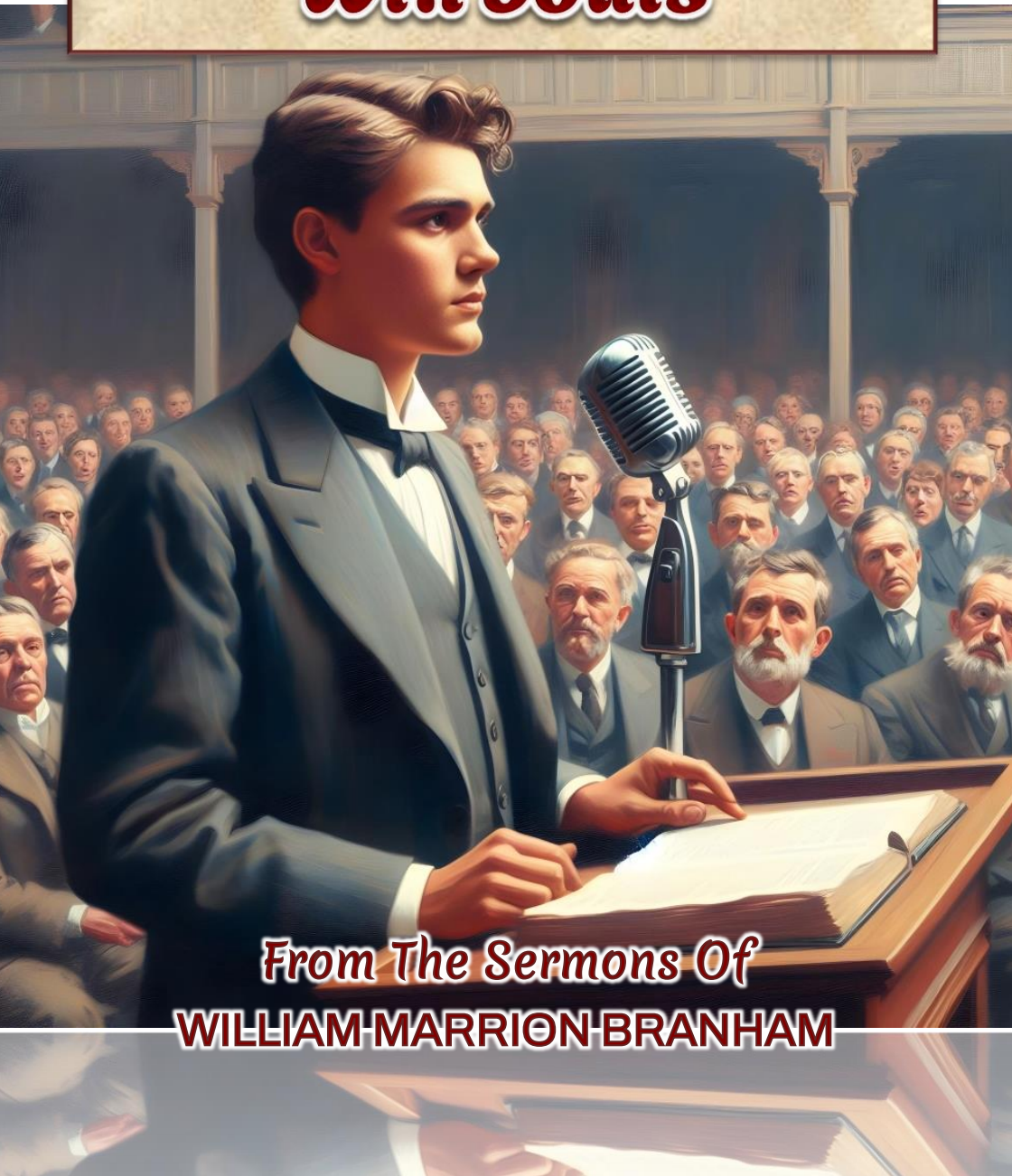
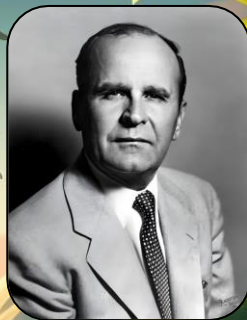

How many people you get out for Wednesday night prayer meeting?

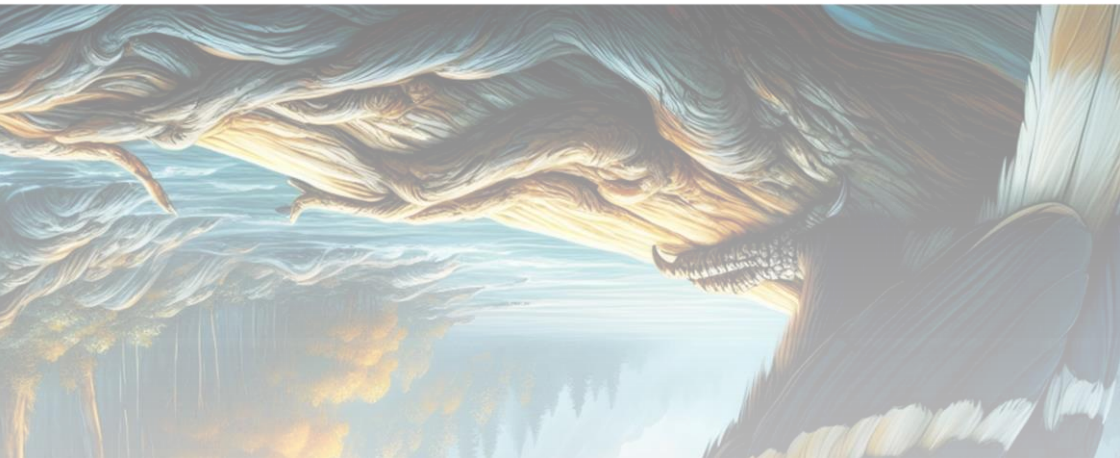
If you're not doing it, you ought to be ashamed of yourself before Christ.

You're guilty, and your place is at the altar.

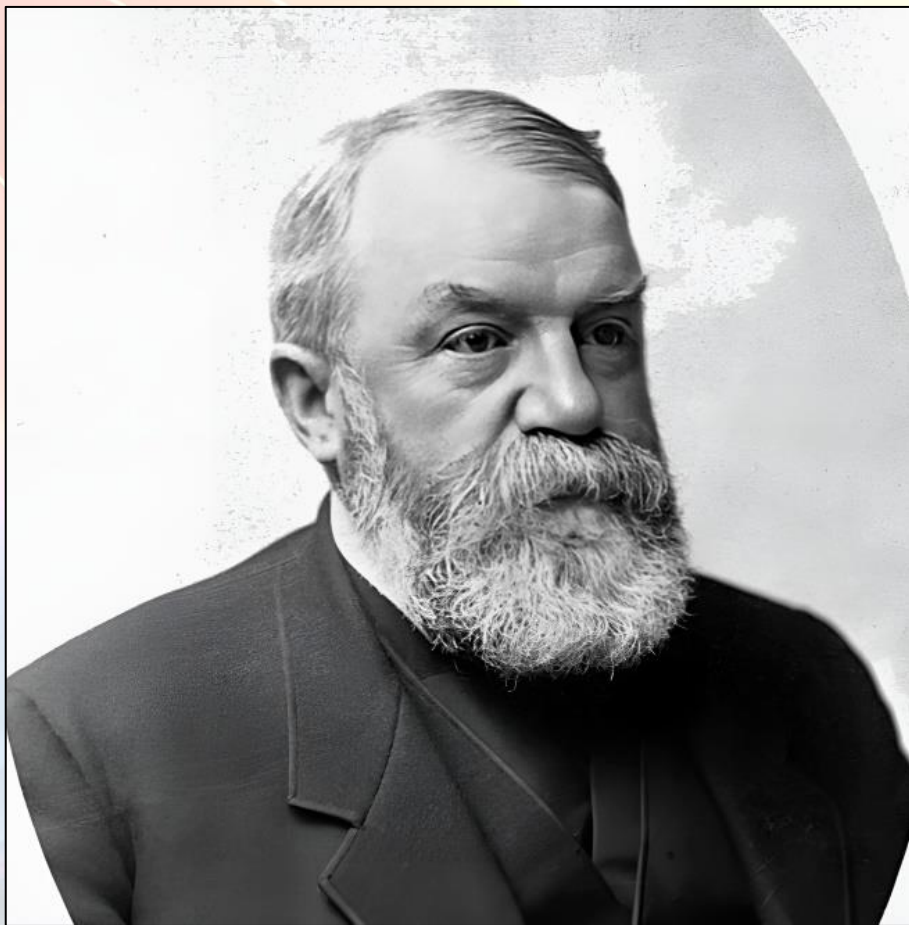

53 I come here, friends, one time, during the depression, when I preached in overalls. And you walked for miles, in here, and crossed the country, and not

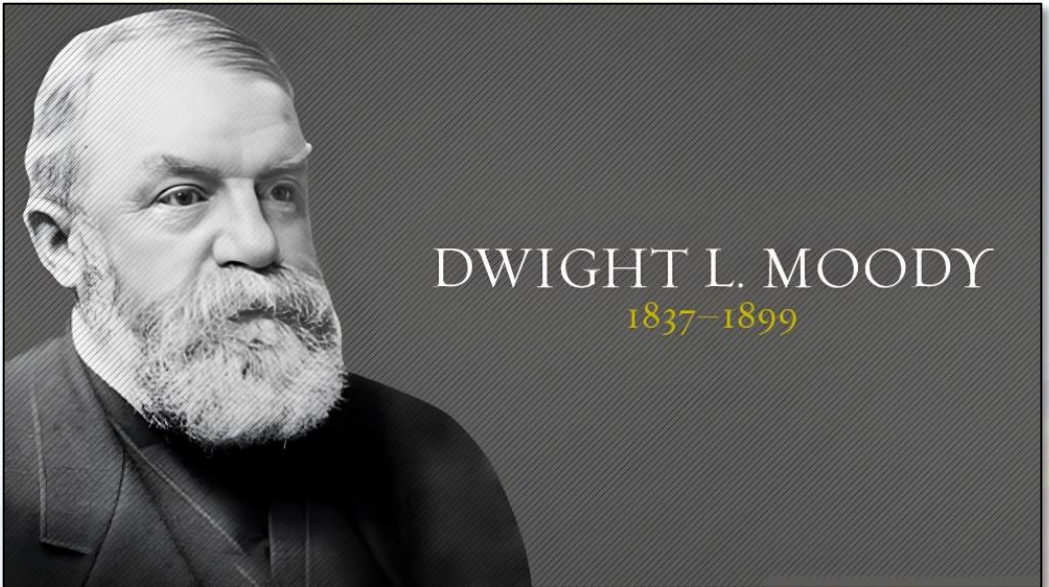
enough to eat. And I know. That's right. I remember it. God has blessed us, and we're grateful to Him, see.

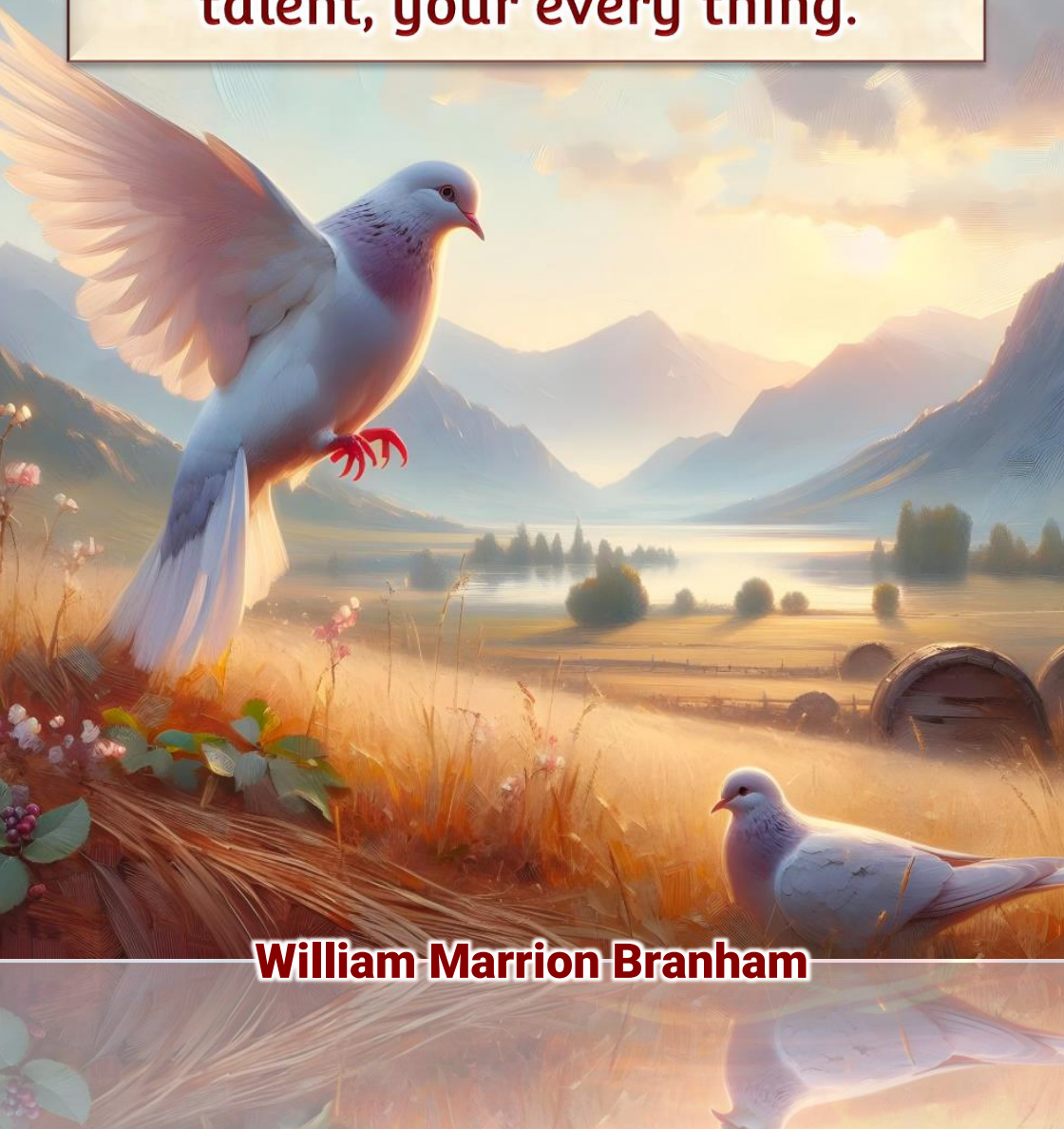

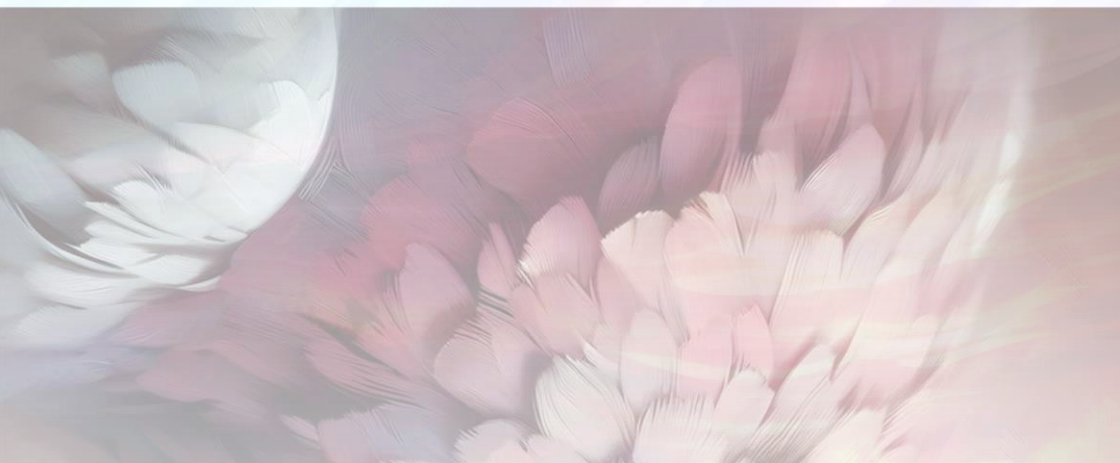

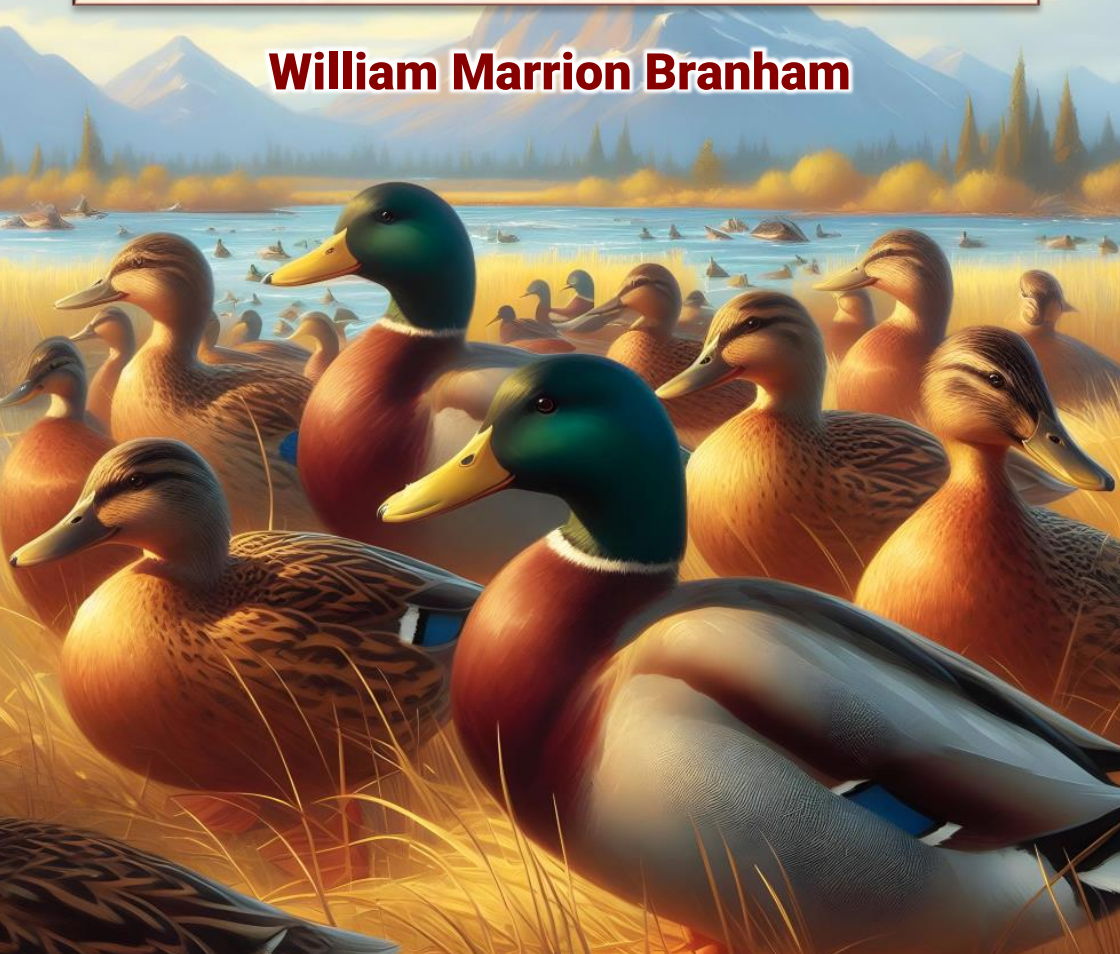
37 And all through the eternities you'll enjoy the blessings of God if you bring a

But what I know about Jesus, I love to tell others.

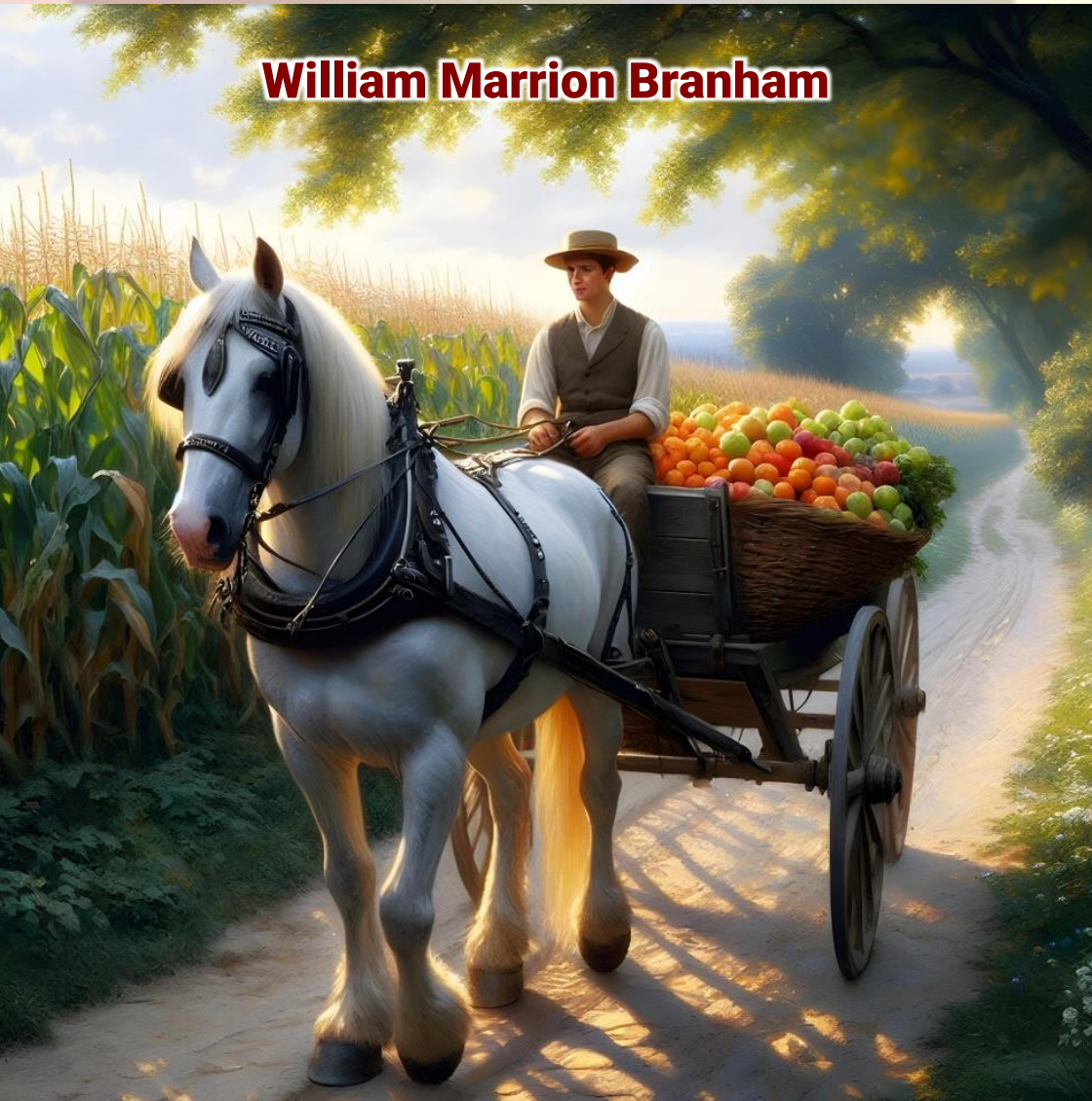

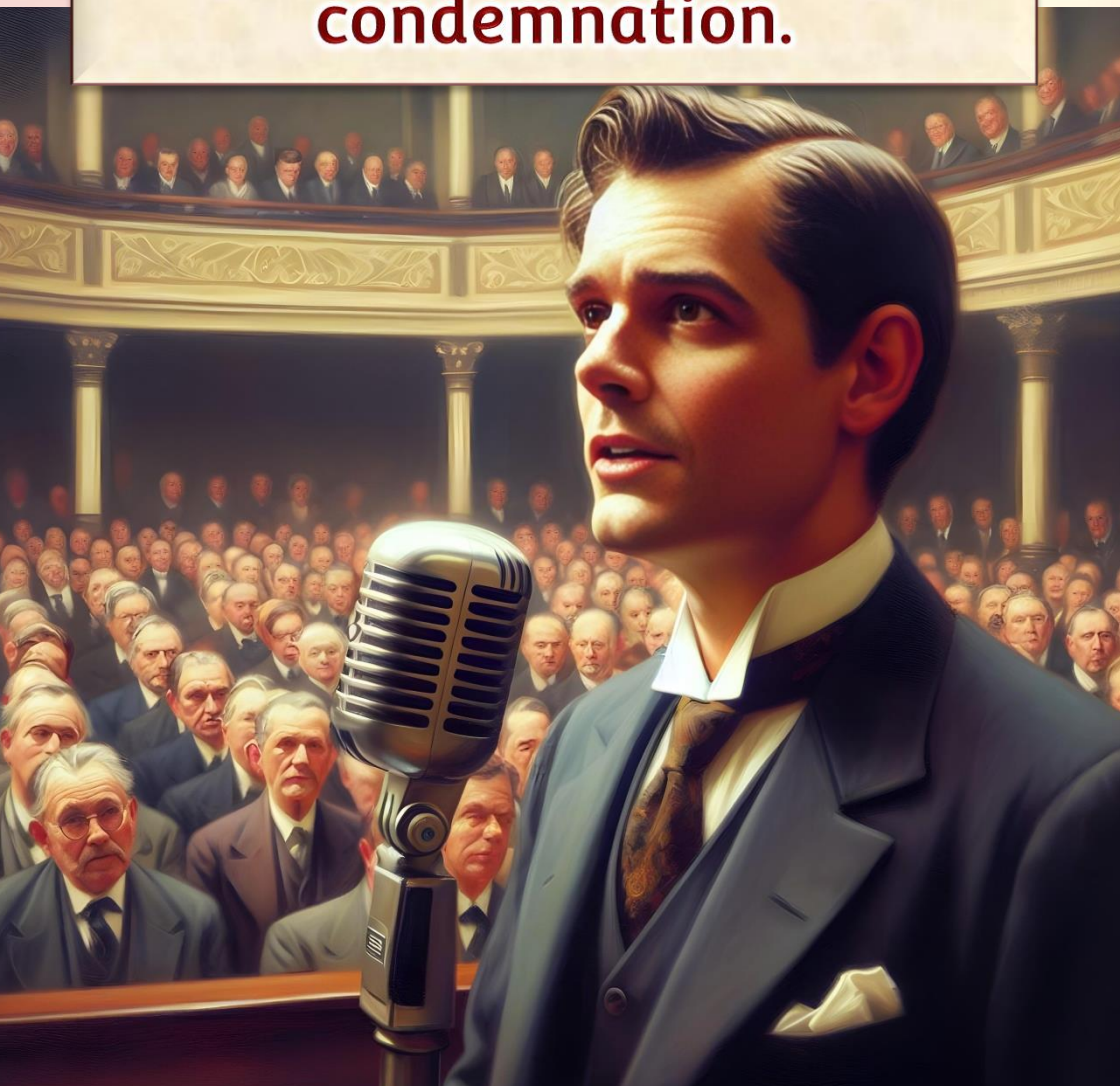

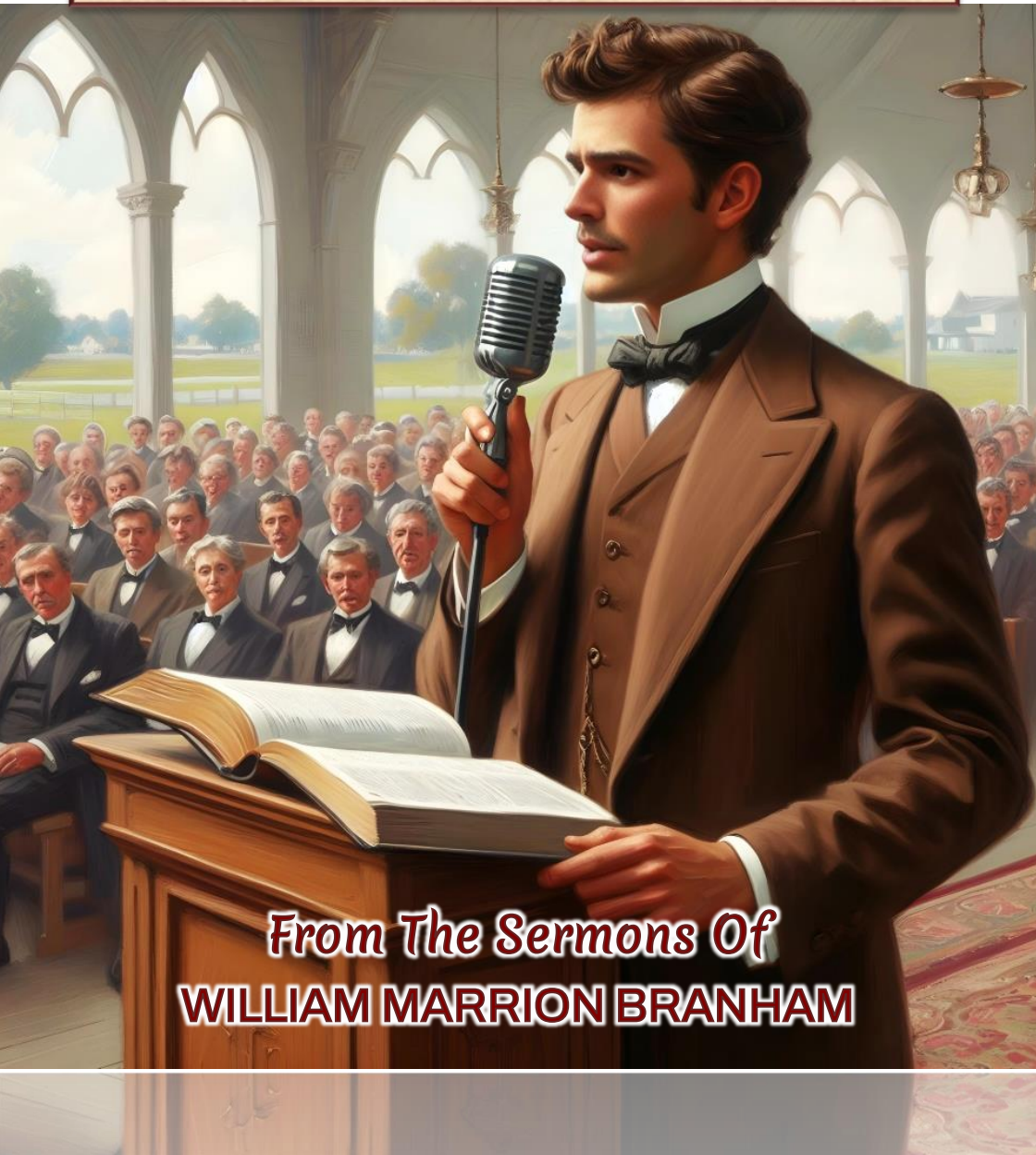
