24 Notice. We're painting an awful dark picture down here. Let's turn our camera up this way once.

Oh, my. Always when there's anything going on down here, there's something going on up there also. There's always two sides to it, you know. When Satan's on the job, Jesus is also. Ever who you yield your faith to, that's the way it's going. Give it to Christ.

Let's look up this way. You know, I can see Him setting up there in His majesty. His priestly robes draped around Him, looking down.

I see coming to His right a great Angel. His name's Gabriel, great Archangel. He comes running up, pulls His sword. He said, "Master, have You looked down in Babylon? Your people's taking a stand for You down there. The hour has come for them to stand, and they're taking a stand. But that bunch of people there is going to push them into that fiery furnace. And let me go down there. I'll clean that thing up."

I believe He could've done it. Yes, sir. He said He will give His Angels charge over these. And I believe the Angels of God are encamped about those who fear Him.

219 They get down to the river. Oh, it's a great big river, second biggest in the world, about. And so, then, great big river, and swift, and just full of great big crocodiles and alligators. And then she [Brother Branham makes a kissing sound three times—Ed.] kiss it. And said, "Now, Aaron, you can kiss it." And Aaron kisses it. And then take it over to Miriam, and she kisses it. And mother kiss it, and, "Oh," she said, "I just..."

222 "Now, sh-sh-sh! Now listen, we got to be soldiers. See? We got to be soldiers. Now you all want to kiss it again?" All of them kiss it, around, again. Then they put him in there.

223 And mother made the little blanket, and put on it, and little pillow. She put it on there. She said, "My darling little baby, God bless you." "Sh-sh-sh! Now, God will take care of that. Don't you worry."

224 Closed the little lid down. And the first thing you know, father begins to pull off his coat, take off his shirt. Here he goes, wading out into the water.

225 What do you think is going on in Heaven, about this time? Hallelujah! You know, when things goes on down here, there is something going on up There, too. Amen! I can see God raise from His Throne, walk over, say, "Gabriel! Gabriel! Where are you?"

Gabriel say, "Here I am, Lord."

226 "Come here! Going to show you something!" Said, "All you Angels come around here, a minute, I want to show you something. I got people that believe Me. Yes, I got people who trust Me. Come here, a minute! It's good for all you Angels, take a look at this. Look!"

"Where is it at?"

"Right down there. Look out."

"Yeah, yeah. Yeah, I see it."

227 "Look right down there. See the edge of them—them—them bulrushes there, them flags and things?"

"Yeah."

"See there!"

"What is it?"

228 "There's a man with his hands up in the air, on his knees, calling on Me. There is a crying mother, and two little crying children. They're trusting Me to the very end. Gabriel, you remember when you went in? You remember that man?"

229 "Yes, I met in the room that night and talked to him. Uh-huh."

230 "He still trusts Me. I got people that believe Me! I got people that will trust Me to the end!" [Brother Branham knocks on the pulpit six times—Ed.] "See him? Look at him."

"Yes, oh, isn't that gallant!"

231 The father is walking in the water, starts to push the little boat out.

I can hear Him say, "Gabriel!"

"Yes, Lord?"

232 "Call ten thousand Angels to the scene. Give them marching orders right away. Call the hosts of Heaven out. Send them all up-and-down, along the banisters of Heaven, and put them all upand-down the Nile. I command that no crocodile will touch that cargo! Nothing will touch it! Don't even let a chunk of wood come near it." Hallelujah!

233 Gabriel said, "It shall be done." My! He sounded a trumpet! Ten thousand Angels come in arm!

"The Pilot. Where You going to be, Lord?"

234 "I'll be at the other end." He's always on the receiving end. "I'll wait down at the other end. I got a purpose. When people will trust Me, I have something, a purpose; it'll be all right with them." All right, He goes down at the other end.

310 Bless all these little boys and girls around the altar. Bless the mothers and fathers that's here this morning. Oh, may Thy loving grace and mercy be upon them all. Forgive us, Lord, of all of our sins and shortcomings. Take sickness from our midst.

I can see those Israelites that had just passed through the Red Sea; had just been redeemed by the blood; seen the healing Power of God, or the miraculous Power standing between God...and between Israel and Egypt; and had drown the enemies behind that.

205 And that's the dimension now, by being born. Maybe you never will (See?) see such. But you believe it anyhow. "How much greater is their reward who has never seen and yet believe." But some of us were born for that. God places that in the church, from baby birth. Prophets are not just put in by man; it's a gift borned; all through the Scripture, born from childhood.

34 Can't fail, there's no failing in it. It don't rest upon what I do; it's rest upon what He did. Amen. It's already finished. The believer once anchored in Christ Jesus, coming through the door back there, put on this highway, you can't get any way but straight up to God with it, Angels to take care of you. God made a way of this.

When He seen in the beginning, in our first parent's fall, He seen the covenant He made with Adam; He tried to hook the ladder into him, and it failed. Then there's nothing else He could hook it to, but to bring down His own Son and hook it to Him. So it can't fail now. So what we worried about? What we stewing about? Why we go along, great big long face? Let's look up and grin. Look up, and not only grin, but laugh, not only laugh, but raise up holy hands everywhere, giving praise and glory to God, for His promises is yea and amen, not yes and no, not yes and no, but yes. There's no no in it. Yes.

35 Our foundation stands sure. Foundation of God... God laid in Zion the cornerstone. There we are, can't slip, can't slide, can't move. Then we come into the door, through Christ, put on here. Oh, we may have our ups-and-downs along; that's true enough, sicknesses and troubles. But remember, there's a great company of Angels all

along the road, bear thee up any time. Taking you on up when you fall. Oh, yes, He's there. He promised it. And He had to make a way of it.
